## For An Act To Be Entitled

10 "AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE MEMBERS OF THE POST PRISON  
11 TRANSFER BOARD AND THEIR INVESTIGATORS, WHO HAVE BEEN  
12 ISSUED CONCEALED HANDGUN PERMITS, TO CARRY THEIR  
13 HANDGUNS IN THE SAME CIRCUMSTANCES AS OTHER LAW  
14 ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS WHEN ON BOARD DUTY; AND FOR OTHER  
15 PURPOSES. "

## Subtitle

18 "TO AUTHORIZE MEMBERS OF THE POST PRISON  
19 TRANSFER BOARD AND THEIR INVESTIGATORS,  
20 WHO HAVE BEEN ISSUED CONCEALED HANDGUN  
21 PERMITS, TO CARRY THEIR HANDGUNS IN THE  
22 SAME CIRCUMSTANCES AS OTHER LAW  
23 ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS WHEN ON BOARD DUTY"

26 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
27

28 SECTION 1. Members of the Post Prison Transfer Board and board  
29 investigators, who have been issued a concealed handgun permit by the  
30 Department of Arkansas State Police pursuant to Subchapter 3, Chapter 73,  
31 Title 5 of the Arkansas Code, are authorized to carry their concealed handguns  
32 in any building in or location on which law enforcement officers are  
33 authorized to carry handguns provided that the board members and investigators  
34 are on official business of the board.  
35

36 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature

1 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code  
2 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

3  
4 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to  
5 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect  
6 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without  
7 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this  
8 act are declared to be severable.

9  
10 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are  
11 hereby repealed.
