It is unlawful for a person under eighteen (18) years of age to possess, unless acting as an agent of his employer within the scope of 25 26 employment, purchase, or use any cigarettes or other tobacco products. Persons 27 under eighteen (18) years of age may be enlisted to assist an authorized agent 28 or representative of a state or local law enforcement authority, the Arkansas 29 Tobacco Control Board, the Arkansas Department of Health, or other state 30 governmental agency in testing compliance with laws relating to the 31 prohibition of the sale of tobacco in any form or cigarette papers to minors, 32 provided the testing is conducted under the direction or supervision of an 33 authorized agent or representative of a state or local law enforcement authority, the Arkansas Tobacco Control Board, the Arkansas Department of 34 35 Health, or other governmental agency monitoring illegal sales of tobacco to minors, and written parental or legal guardian consent has been provided after 36

1	the consenting parent or guardian has received from the testing entity written
2	information about the duties which such persons under eighteen (18) years of
3	age will be asked to perform and the methods and procedures to be employed in

6	SECTION 2. Any cigarettes or tobacco products found in the possession
7	of a person under eighteen (18) years of age may be confiscated by a certified
8	law enforcement officer or a school official and immediately destroyed.
9	
10	SECTION 3. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
11	are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
12	Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.
13	
14	SECTION 4. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
15	any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
16	other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
17	the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
18	act are declared to be severable.

20	SECTION 5. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
