4	SECTION 2. Act 235 of 1991, as amended by Act 923 of 1991,
5	<u>notwithstanding, State Building Services is hereby authorized to construct,</u>
6	<u>manage and maintain a parking deck facility, surface parking and street</u>
7	improvements in the area described in § 22-3-302(a). State Building Services
8	shall not be responsible for maintaining or assigning parking spaces
9	designated for use by constitutional offices or the General Assembly.
10	
11	SECTION 3. State Building Services shall develop parking regulations
12	which will maintain equitable parking among the state agency tenants in the
13	area described in Section 1, and for the public, and may establish reasonable
14	rental or other charges for parking therein. The State Capitol Police shall
15	provide the necessary traffic patrols and policing of the parking facility.
16	
17	SECTION 4. <u>State Building Services, on behalf of the State of Arkansas,</u>
18	is hereby granted an easement or license over the State Capitol, the various
19	buildings on the State Capitol grounds, and the State Capitol grounds, for the
20	purpose of installing or relocating utilities, connecting the facility to an
21	existing structure, and such other purposes necessary and consistent with this
22	project as authorized by this act.

24	SECTION 5. State Building Services is authorized and empowered to
25	obtain the necessary funds for accomplishing its powers, purposes, and
26	authority from any source or sources necessary and consistent with this act.

28	SECTION 6. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
29	are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
30	Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

32	SECTION 7. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
33	any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect

5	SECTION 9. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the		
6	Eighty-second General Assembly that the effectiveness of this act on July 1,		
7	1999, is essential to the operation of the state government and that in the		
8	event of an extension of the regular session, the delay of this act beyond		
9	July 1, 1999, could work irreparable harm upon the proper administration and		
10	provision of essential governmental programs, as well as the public.		
11	Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist and this act being immediately		
12	necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall		
13	<u>become effective on July 1, 1999.</u>
