*4-99-302.* Prohibition.

It is a violation of this subchapter for any person to make or transmit a telephone solicitation while using any method, including but not limited to per-call blocking or per-line blocking, that prevents caller identification information for the telephone solicitor's lines used to make telephone calls to a consumer from being shown by a device capable of displaying caller identification information.

4-99-303. Penalties, remedies, and enforcement.

(a) When a person violates this subchapter or a regulation prescribed under this subchapter, the violation shall constitute an unfair or deceptive act or practice as defined in Chapter 88 of Title 4 of the Arkansas Code pertaining to deceptive trade practices. All remedies, penalties, and authority granted to the Attorney General under Chapter 88 of Title 4 of the Arkansas Code shall be available to the Attorney General for enforcement of this subchapter.

(b) The remedies and penalties provided by this section are cumulative to each other and the remedies or penalties available under all other laws of
