18	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

20	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 17-96-101 is amended to read as follows:			
21	"17-96-101. Definitions.			
22	As used in this chapter, unless the context otherwise requires:			
23	(1) 'Podiatric medicine' means the diagnosis and medical, mechanical,			
24	and surgical treatment o	f ailments of the human foot <u>an</u>	d ankle;	
25	(2) 'Podiatrist' means a physician legally licensed to practice			
26	podiatric medicine. However, no podiatrist shall amputate the human foot or			
27	perform nerve or vascular grafting or administer any anesthetic other than a			
28	local anesthetic. All ankle surgery performed above the level of the foot			
29	other than skin and skin structures shall be performed in a facility			
30	accredited by either Medicare or by the Joint Commission on Accreditation of			
31	<u>Health Care Organization</u>	<u>s;</u> and		
32	(3) 'Board' means	the Arkansas Board of Podiatri	c Medicine."

34	SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature			
35	are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code			
36	Revision Commission shall	I incorporate the same in the C	ode.
