

1 SECTION 10. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized 2 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds 3 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the 4 restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures 5 and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of 6 7 this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied 8 9 with in disbursement of said funds.

11 SECTION 11. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly 12 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained 13 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act 14 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations 15 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral 16 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint 17 18 Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

20 SECTION 12. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent 21 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas 22 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

SECTION 13. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this act are declared to be severable.

30 SECTION 14. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with 31 this act are hereby repealed.

33 SECTION 15. <u>EMERGENCY CLAUSE.</u> It is hereby found and determined by the 34 <u>Eighty-second General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas</u> 35 <u>prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that</u> 36 the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 1999 is essential to the operation of
