

25	SECTION 1. Ark	ansas Code 24-11-301 is amended to	read as follows:
26	"24-11-301. Ар	ppropriation of tax revenues from fo	reign insurers.
27	(a) Sixty-six	and two-thirds percent (66 2/3%) o	f the total tax
28	revenues derived from	n premium taxes paid to the State of	Arkansas by alien and
29	foreign insurance com	npanies upon premiums collected by t	he insurance companies
30	upon insurance contra	acts written on motor vehicles, the	licensed addresses of
31	which are qualified c	ities or towns wherein the motor ve	hicles are insured
32	against the peril of	physical damage or the owner or ope	rators of the motor
33	vehicles are insured	against legal liability arising out	of the use,
34	ownership, or operati	on of the motor vehicles is appropr	iated and set aside
35	for the use and benef	fit of all duly qualified police off	icers' pension and

3	<u>(1)</u>	The premium taxes collected in this subsection shall be
4		placed in a fund combined with the premium taxes collected
5		pursuant to Arkansas Code Annotated § 24-11-809. The
6		combined fund shall be entitled the Firemen's and Police
7		Officers' Pension and Relief Fund.
8	<u>(2)</u>	Each calendar year the Insurance Commissioner shall
9		determine the total gross amount collected pursuant to this
10		act and Arkansas Code Annotated § 24-11-809. The Insurance
11		<u>Commissioner shall withdraw six point two percent (6.2%) of</u>
12		the total gross amount collected for this fund and transfer
13		such to the General Revenue of the State of Arkansas."
14	(3)	For the 1999-2000 fiscal year, six hundred thousand dollars
15		(\$600,000) shall be transferred to the Fire Protection
16		Premium Tax Fund, from the six point two percent (6.2%) that
17		would have otherwise accrued to General Revenues, and in all
18		subsequent years, fifty percent (50%) of the increase in
19		premium taxes from the six point two percent (6.2%) of the
20		total gross amount collected, using the dollar amount
21		collected in fiscal year 1999-2000 as the baseline, shall be
22		transferred to the Fire Protection Premium Tax Fund in
23		addition to the six hundred thousand dollars (\$600,000) per
24		year, until such time that a cap of two million dollars
25		(\$2,000,000) annually is transferred to the Fire Protection
26		Premium Tax Fund. Thereafter, the annual transfer shall be
27		<u>set at two million dollars (\$2,000,000).</u>
28	<u>(4)</u>	The remaining revenues collected pursuant to §§ 23-60-102,
29		<u>24-11-301, 24-11-302, 24-11-809, 24-11-810, 26-57-60126-</u>
30		57-605, and 26-57-607 shall be distributed to the Firemen's
31		and Police Officers' Pension and Relief Fund and to the
32		<u>State of Arkansas as general revenues.</u>
33		(A) The revenues shall be distributed in such a manner
34		that the Firemen's and Police Officers' Pension and
35		Relief Fund and the general revenue fund will each
36		receive distributions of no less than they received in

1		<u>fiscal year 1999; except that:</u>
2		(i) If the revenues to be distributed in a
3		subsequent year are less that the revenues
4		<u>distributed in 1999 then the distributions to</u>
5		<u>each shall be reduced proportionately; and</u>
6		(ii) If additional police departments become eligible
7		for distributions from the Firemen's and Police
8		<u>Officers' Pension and Relief Fund, the base</u>
9		amount for the state shall be reduced in
10		proportion to the population in the area served
11		by the police department to the portion of the
12		population of the state not covered by a police
13		department receiving a distribution from the
14		fund.
15	<u>(B)</u>	Except as provided in subdivision (4)(A), the portion
16		<u>distributed to the Firemen's and Police Officers'</u>
17		Pension and Relief Fund shall be based on the ratio
18		percentage of the total population of the cities or
19		towns qualified to participate in such fund in
20		comparison to the total population of the State of
21		Arkansas. The remaining percentage shall be
22		<u>distributed to the State of Arkansas' general revenue</u>
23		fund.
24	(b) The amount o	of the tax revenue attributable to the fire peril of
25	physical dan	age insurance shall not be included.
26	(c) The payment f	for the administrative and actuarial expenses of the
27	Arkansas Fire and Police Pension Review Board shall be made prior to the	
28	disbursements to the eli	gible political subdivisions.″
29		
30	SECTION 2. All pr	ovisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
31	are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code	
32	Revision Commission shal	I incorporate the same in the Code.
33		
34	SECTION 3. If any	provision of this act or the application thereof to
35	any person or circumstan	ce is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
36	other provisions or appl	ications of the act which can be given effect without

1	the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this		
2	act are declared to be severable.

4	SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are		
5	hereby repealed.
