## BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTI ON 1. REGULAR SALARIES - OPERATI ONS. There is her eby establ ished for the Uni versity of Arkansas for Medical Sci ences for the 1999-2001 bi enni um, the following maxi mum number of regul ar employees whose sal aries shall be governed by the provisi ons of the Uni form Cl assification and Compensation Act (Arkansas Code §§21-5-201 et seq.), or its successor, and all laws amendatory ther et o. Provided, however, that any position to whi ch a specific maximum annual sal ary is set out herein in dollars, shall be exempt from the provisions of said Uni formCl assification and Compensation Act. All persons occupying positions authorized her ei $n$ are hereby governed by the provi si ons of the Regul ar Sal aries Procedures and Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5101), or its successor.

SECTI ON 11. SPECI AL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE I NCORPORATED I NTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLI SHED SEPARATELY AS SPECI AL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW ARKANSAS

CHI LDREN' S HOSPI TAL. Thirty-three and one-third percent (33-1/3\%) in each fiscal year of the biennial period ending June 30, 1999 2001, of the amounts made available to fund the appropriation in Item(07) of Section 6 of this Act shall be di stributed to the Arkansas Children's Hospital.

SECTI ON 12. SPECI AL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE I NCORPORATED I NTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLI SHED SEPARATELY AS SPECI AL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW SPECI AL ALLOWANCES. The Board of Trustees may make special allowances available, in such amounts as the Board may determ ne or justify equitable in view of the exacting duties which are invol ved, as a part of the sal aries of the physicians, dentists, and other professional faculty employed by the Uni versity of Arkansas for Medical Sciences fromrecei pts of professional income in the care of patients and/ or funds recei ved fromfederal agencies, foundations, and ot her private sponsors in support of research. Provided that any such allowance shall not exceed, for any employee, an amount equal to two and one half ( $2 \& 1 / 2$ ) times that portion of the sal ary authorized by the General Assembly to be paid fromthe Uni versity of Arkansas Medical Center Fund.

SECTI ON 13. SPECI AL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE I NCORPORATED I NTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLI SHED SEPARATELY AS SPECI AL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW SPECI AL ALLOWANCES. The Board of Trustees of the Uni versity of Arkansas is hereby authorized to make available to the President of the University of Arkansas special allowances in such amounts as the Board may determine to be justified at the Uni versity of Arkansas for Medical Sciences, for the use of the Chancellor and his deans, representatives, department heads, and directors at the Uni versity of Arkansas for Medical Sciences in recruitment of faculty and staff members. Upon approval by the President and the Board of Trustees, such funds shall be administered by the Chancellor, who shall assure that the total amount expended for such purposes does not exceed one hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$150,000) each fiscal year or so much thereof as may be authorized by the Board of Trustees. The funds authorized by this Section shall come froma source other than state tax dollars appropriated by the General Assentoly or charges made to students for tuition, fees, room and board, or other purposes. Each year the Chancellor shall furnish to the President of the Uni versity of Arkansas, the Board of Trustees, and the Arkansas Legi slative Joint Auditing

Committee a report showing for each expenditure the date, the amount, the names of persons to whom the expenditure was made, and the purpose for whi ch the expenditure was made.

SECTI ON 14. SPECI AL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE I NCORPORATED I NTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLI SHED SEPARATELY AS SPECI AL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW SPECI AL LANGUAGE AND RESTRI CTI ONS - AREA HEALTH EDUCATI ON CENTERS. The Chancel I or at the Uni versity of Arkansas for Medical Sci ences shall make periodic progress reports of AHEC programs to the Governor, the Legi slative Council, and ot her interested interim committees of the General Assembly regarding the achi evements, the expansi on of the af orementioned prograns, and amounts expended for the Area Heal th Education Centers.

SECTI ON 15. SPECI AL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE I NCORPORATED I NTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLI SHED SEPARATELY AS SPECI AL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW CONTRACT RESTRI CTI ONS ( PHYSI CI AN TEACHERS AND TEACHERS I N OTHER HEALTH RELATED PROFESSI ONS) AREA HEALTH EDUCATI ON CENTERS. Funds appropri at ed by thi s Act may be utilized for the purpose of contracting with physician-teachers and teachers in other heal th rel ated professions residing only at sites located away fromthe Uni versity of Arkansas for Medical Sciences. Such funds are to be paid onl y for the purpose of teaching residents and students assi gned to Area Health Education Centers. Contracts entered into with physicianteachers, teachers in other health rel ated fields and their associ at es shall require the prior approval of the Chi ef Fiscal Officer of the State only and be reported quarterly to the Legislative Council.

SECTI ON 16. SPECI AL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE I NCORPORATED I NTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLI SHED SEPARATELY AS SPECI AL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW SPECI AL PROVI SI ONS FOR UNCLASSI FIED PATI ENT CARE PERSONNEL. Al I uncl assi fied positions employed to provide patient care at the Uni versity of Arkansas for Medi cal Sci ences are eligi ble for overtime at the rate of one and one-hal f times their regul ar hourly rate. In addition to overtime, those unclassified patient care empl oyees schedul ed to work shifts outside of normal oper ating schedul es may be el i gi ble to recei ve up to twenty-four (24) percent of the hourly rate paid as a shift differential. In addition, all uncl assified positions employed to provide patient care at the Uni versity of Arkansas for

Medi cal Sciences will be eligible to receive incentive pay not to exceed 1.2 times thei $r$ base hourly rate. Empl oyees requi red to be available for duty on ni ghts, weekends and hol idays will be el i gi ble to recei ve standby pay equi val ent of up to four hours of work per shift. Employees required to work in specialty areas will be eligi ble to recei ve up to ten (10) percent of the hourly rate paid as a specialty differential while working in such areas. When overtime, shift differentials, standby pay, i ncentive pay and/ or specialty differential are provided to employees as her ei $n$ described, the total may exceed the line item maximusal aries for those positions as incl uded in this Act. The positions of Patient Care Administrator, Associ ate Admin ni strator, and Assistant Administrator of Patient Care as authorized in Section 1 of this Act shall be excluded from cover age of this Section. In addition, the Board of Trustees may al so make special compensation allowances available, in such anounts as the Board may determ ne or justify equitable in vi ew of the current requi rements for Regi stered Nurses in the Cl i ni cal Prograns of the Uni versity of Arkansas for Medical Sci ences and the avail ability of Registered Nurses for employment in the Little Rock metropolitan area. However, under no condition shall the special allowances approved by the Board of Trustees for a single indi vidual exceed the state I i ne item maxi mum by more than $20 \%$ for those positions included in this Act.

SECTI ON 17. SPECI AL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE I NCORPORATED I NTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLI SHED SEPARATELY AS SPECI AL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW DAY CARE. Of the funds appropriated in Section 6 of this Act, $\$ 250,000$ each year of the bi enni um may be allocated as the State's portion of the operating cost of a Child Care Facility of the Uni versity of Arkansas for Medical Sciences. I ndi vi dual s using this facility will be charged a daily rate as determined by the Uni versity of Arkansas for Medical Sci ences.

SECTI ON 18. SPECI AL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE I NCORPORATED I NTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLI SHED SEPARATELY AS SPECI AL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW CARRY FORWARD. Any unexpended bal ance of the gener al revenue appropriations and funds provi ded by this Act whi ch remai ns at the close of the fiscal year ending J une 30, 1998 2000, not to exceed ten percent (10\%) of funded appropriations, shall be carried forward and made available for the same purpose for the fiscal year ending June 30, $1999 \underline{2001 .}$

Any unexpended bal ance of cash fund appropriations provi ded by this Act whi ch remai ns at the close of the fiscal year ending June 30, 19982000 , not to exceed ten percent ( $10 \%$ of funded appropriations, shall be carried forward and made available as contingency for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1999 2001.

SECTI ON 19. SPECI AL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE I NCORPORATED I NTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLI SHED SEPARATELY AS SPECI AL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW STI PENDS. The Uni versity of Arkansas for Medical Sciences is hereby authorized to pay stipends to students engaged in post-graduate clinical training in accredited prograns of the Uni versity of Arkansas for Medical Sci ences, from "Regul ar Sal aries" or "Mai ntenance and General Oper ation", as follows:

SECTI ON 20. SPECI AL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE I NCORPORATED I NTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLI SHED SEPARATELY AS SPECI AL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW ADM SSI ON POLI CY. The Uni versity of Arkansas for Medical Sciences shall admit one hundred fifty (150) freshman students in each year of the 1997-99 1999-2001 bi enni uminto the Coll ege of Medicine. Provided that no funds shall be expended to fund the positions of Chancellor, Dean of Medicine and any academ c position until the Chancellor and Dean of Medicine certify to the Arkansas Legi slative Council that the provision of this Section rel ating to the 1997-99 1999-2001 bi enni um requi rement for one hundred fifty (150) freshman student admissi ons has been i mpl emented.

SECTI ON 21. SPECI AL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE I NCORPORATED I NTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLI SHED SEPARATELY AS SPECI AL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW CHAPLAI N HOUSI NG ALLOWANCE. The Chancel l or of the Uni versity of Arkansas for Medical

Sciences may designate up to forty-five per cent (45\%) of the regular gross sal ary (or stipend) of a minter or other clergy employed as a Chaplain or appoi nted as a Chapl ai $n$ Resident, as a housing allowance, to the extent used by the person to rent or provi de a home, according to the gui del ines of the Internal Revenue Service Code, Section 107 and the Arkansas Code 26-51404(11).

SECTI ON 22. SPECI AL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE I NCORPORATED I NTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLI SHED SEPARATELY AS SPECI AL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW I NDI GENT CARE REI MBURSEMENT. The Uni versity of Arkansas for Medi cal Sciences is hereby authorized to utilize funds appropriated by this Act to extend provisions of Act 688 of 1989 to authorize procedures for the di sbursement of Indigent Care mai ntenance and general operations appropriations to be paid from cash funds of the institution, subj ect to rei mbursement and correction of reporting, as provi ded by Section 1 of Arkansas Code 19-4-1609.

SECTI ON 23. SPECI AL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE I NCORPORATED I NTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLI SHED SEPARATELY AS SPECI AL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW SPECI AL PROVI SI ONS FOR ON- CALL STATUS AND STAND BY PAY FOR CERTAI N CLASSI FI ED EMPLOYEES WORKI NG IN CRI TI CAL AREAS. Al I classified positions employed in areas providing critical and emergency support of the clinical and physical operations of the Uni versity of Arkansas for Medical Sciences and required to work outsi de their normal work schedule shall be eligible for on-call stat us and to recei ve stand-by pay not to exceed four hours of work per shift. When standby pay is provided to employees as herein described, the tot al compensation may exceed the line item maximusal aries for those positions as incl uded in this Act.

SECTI ON 24. SPECI AL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE I NCORPORATED I NTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLI SHED SEPARATELY AS SPECI AL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW ESTABLI SHMENT OF A "GROWTH POOL". (a) The Arkansas Department of Hi gher Education shall establish and mai nt ai $n$ for the 1997-99 1999-2001 bi enni um a pool of three hundred (300) nonclassified positions at a sal ary level not to exceed $\$ 102,504$ per year. These positions are to be used by the Uni versity of Arkansas for Medical Sciences in the event that the personal services needs of the Uni versity during the 1997-99 1999-2001 bi enni um exceed the number of
positions allocated to the Uni versity by the Legi slat ure. The Uni versity shall provide justification to the Arkansas Department of Higher Education for the need to allocate titles fromthis "growth pool ". No classifications will be assigned to the pool until such time as specific positions are requested by the Uni versity, approved by the Uni versity Board or their desi gnee, and reviewed approved by the Legislative Council. Furthermore, the Office of Personnel Management (OPM) of the Division of Management Services of the Department of Fi nance and Administration shall establish and maintain for the 1997-99 1999-2001 bi enni um a pool of three hundred (300) classified positions at up to a grade 26. These positions are to be used by the Uni versity of Arkansas for Medical Sciences in the event that the personal services needs of the Uni versity during the 1997-99 1999-2001 bi enni um exceed the number of positions in a classification allocated to the Uni versity by the Legislat are. The Uni versity shall provide justification to OPM for the need to allocate titles fromthis "growth pool". No classifications will be assigned to the pool until such time as specific positions are requested by the Uni versity, recomended by OPM and review approved by the Legi slative Council. (b) Determining the number of personnel to be employed by a state agency is the prerogative of the General Assembly and is usually accomplished by del ineating the maxi mum number of personnel by identifying the job titles and the maxi mum grade or sal ary attached to those sal aries. The General Assembly has determined that the Uni versity of Arkansas for Medical Sciences could be operated more efficiently if some flexibility is given to that institution. That flexibility is being accomplished by provi ding growth pool s in subsection (a) of this section and since the General Assembly has granted the institution broad powers under the grouth pool concept, it is both necessary and appropriate that the General Assembly maintain oversight of the utilization of the growth pool by requiring prior approval of the Legislative Council in the utilization of the growth pool. Ther ef ore, the requirement of approval by the Legislative Council is not a severable part of this section. If the requirement of approval by the Legislative Council is ruled unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, this entire section is void.

SECTI ON 25. SPECI AL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE I NCORPORATED I NTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLI SHED SEPARATELY AS SPECI AL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW COURSE REQUI REMENTS. The provi si ons of Arkansas Code 6-61-105 and 6-61-106 shal I not
apply to students sel ected to be admitted to the Uni versity of Arkansas School of Medicine or the Uni versity of Arkansas School of Pharmacy.

SECTI ON 26. SPECI AL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE I NCORPORATED I NTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLI SHED SEPARATELY AS SPECI AL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW CH LD HEALTH AND FAM LY LIFE INSTITUTE. The Child Health and Family Life Institute shall be administered under the direction of Arkansas Children's Hospital. Arkansas Children's Hospital shall enter into a cooperative agreement and/or contract with the Uni versity of Arkansas for Medical Sciences - Department of Pedi atrics for servi ces required in delivering the prograns of the Child Health and Family Life Institute. The KI DS FIRST Program a component of the Child Health and Family Life Institute, shall recei ve priority consideration above all other programs of the Institute when funding decisions are made by Arkansas Children's Hospital. Arkansas Children's Hospital shall make quarterly reports to the Arkansas Legislative Council on matters of funding, existing prograns and any new prograns and/ or services offered through the Child Health and Family Life Institute.

The Chancellor of the Uni versity of Arkansas for Medical Sciences shall desi gnate an indi vidual fromthe Department of Pediatrics who shall provide administrative oversight of the cooperative agreements and/or contracts with Arkansas Children's Hospital in delivering the prograns of the Child Health and Family Life Institute. The desi gnated administrator fromthe Uni versity of Arkansas for Medical Sciences-Department of Pediatrics shall make quarterly reports to the Chancellor of the Uni versity of Arkansas for Medical Sciences and the Arkansas Legislative Council on all matters of funding, existing prograns and services offered through the Child Health and Family Life Institute. Further, the Department of Pediatrics shall make every effort to advance the KI DS FI RST Programstat ewi de.

SECTI ON 27. SPECI AL LANGUAGE. PURCHASI NG DEFI NI TI ONS. Arkansas Code Annot at ed 19-11-203(14)(Z) i s hereby amended to read as follows: "(Z) Medical itens used for the treatment and di agnosis of patients if Commodities and services for use in research, education and treat ment for the di agnosis, cure and prevention of di sease may, with administrative approval, be procured through a group purchasing entity serving other public health institutions
when substantial savings are available. A report shall be filed annually with the Divisi on of Legislative Audit reflecting the justification of and the estimated savings accruing due to the use of this exemption;"

SECTI ON 28. SPECI AL LANGUAGE. MDTOR VEHI CLE AUTHORI ZATI ON. Arkansas Code 19-4-906(a)(119) is hereby amended to read as follows:

SECTI ON 29. SPECI AL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE I NCORPORATED I NTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLI SHED SEPARATELY AS SPECI AL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW PARKI NG FEES. On Uuly 1 of each year the Uni versity of Arkansas for Medical Sci ences shall pay from the appropriation provi ded herein from non- general revenue, the total amount appropriated for War Memorial Stadi um Comission Parking Services from Fees to the War Memorial Stadi um Comi ssion.

SECTI ON 30. SPECI AL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE I NCORPORATED I NTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLI SHED SEPARATELY AS SPECI AL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW TRANSFER PROVI SI ONS. Because the Rural Medical Practice Student Loan and Schol arship Program Loans and/ or Schol arshi ps and the Community Match Student Loan and Schol arshi p Program Loans and/ or Schol arshi ps have the goal of provi ding primary care physicians in rural Arkansas, transfers may be made in such amounts as are required between the line itens made in the appropriation for "Medi cal Loans and Schol arshi ps".

SECTI ON 31. APPROPRI ATI ONS - CASH FUNDS. There is her eby appropriated, to the Uni versity of Arkansas, to be payable from cash funds as defined by Arkansas Code 19-4-801 of the Uni versity of Arkansas, for personal services and operating expenses of the Uni versity of Arkansas - Various Divisions which shal I be supplemental and in addition to the appropriation made in Section 6 of Act 431 of 1999, for the bi ennial period ending June 30, 2001, the foll owing:

SECTI ON 32. COMPLI ANCE WTH OTHER LAWS. Di sbur sement of $f$ unds authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regul ar Sal ary Procedures and Restrictions Act, the Hi gher Education Expenditures Restrictions Act, or thei $r$ successors, and other fiscal control laws of this State, where appl i cable, and regul ations promul gated by the Department of Fi nance and Admi ni stration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in di sbur sement of said funds.

SECTI ON 33. LEG SLATI VE I NTENT. It is the i nt ent of the Gener al Assenbly that any funds di sbursed under the authority of the appropriations cont ai ned in this act shall be in compl iance with the stated reasons for whi ch this act was adopted, as evi denced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations and Legi sl at ive Recommendations cont ai ned inthe budget manuals prepared by the Department of Fi nance and Admini stration, l etters, or summarized or al testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee whi ch rel ate to its passage and adoption.

SECTI ON 34. CODE. Al provisions of this Act of a general and permanent nat ure are amendat ory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annot at ed and the Arkansas Code Revisi on Commissi on shall incorporate the same in the Code.

SECTI ON 35. SEVERABI LITY. If any provi si on of thi s act or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is hel dinvalid, such i nval idity shall not affect ot her provisions or applications of the act whi ch can be gi ven effect without the inval id provisi on or application, and to this end the provisions of this act are decl ared to be severable except as provi ded in Section 24 of this Act.

SECTI ON 36. GENERAL REPEALER. Al I I aws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are hereby repeal ed.

SECTI ON 37. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is her eby found and det er min ned by the Ei ghty-second General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohi bits the appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year peri od; that the effect iveness of this Act on July 1, 1999 is essential to the oper ation of the agency for whi ch the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in the event of an extensi on of the Regul ar Session, the del ay in the effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 1999 coul d work irreparable harm upon the proper admi ni stration and provision of essential government al prograns. Ther ef ore, an emergency is her eby decl ared to exi st and this Act being necessary for the i medi ate preservation of the publ ic peace, heal th and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 1999.
