19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
20

21 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 4-18-216(c) is amended to read as follows:

22 "(c)(1) These regulations shall include specifications, tolerances, and
23 regulations for weights and measures of the character of those specified in §
24 4-18-219, designed to eliminate from use, without prejudice to apparatus that
25 conforms as closely as practicable to the official standards, those that are
26 not accurate; those that are of such construction that they are faulty, that
27 is, that are not reasonably permanent in their adjustment or will not repeat
28 their indications correctly; or those that facilitate the perpetration of
29 fraud.

30 (2) The specifications, tolerances, and regulations for
31 commercial weighing and measuring devices, together with amendments thereto,
32 as recommended by the ~~National Bureau of Standards~~ National Institute of
33 Standards and Technology and published in ~~National Bureau of Standards~~
34 Handbook National Institute of Standards and Technology Handbook 44, Handbook
35 130 and supplements thereto, or in any publication revising or superseding
36 Handbook 44 and Handbook 130, shall be the specifications, tolerances, and

1 regulations for commercial weighing and measuring devices of the State of
2 Arkansas except insofar as specifically modified, amended, or rejected by a
3 regulation issued by the Arkansas Bureau of Standards.”
4

5 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
6 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
7 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.
8

9 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
10 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
11 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
12 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
13 act are declared to be severable.
14

15 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
16 hereby repealed.
