22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

24 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES - OPERATIONS. There is hereby established for
25 the Bureau of Legislative Research of the Legislative Council for the ~~1997-99~~
26 1999-2001 biennium, the following maximum number of regular employees, the
27 grades to be assigned to the respective positions, and the maximum annual
28 salaries for each such position. The maximum annual salary for the position
29 assigned to grades shall be determined in accordance with, but shall not
30 exceed the maximum annual amount for the grade assigned herein, as established
31 in Arkansas Code 21-5-209. ~~The maximum annual salary of the Director,~~
32 ~~Assistant Directors, Special Assistant for Budget, Senior Staff Attorney,~~
33 ~~Chief Economist, State Personnel Review Administrator, and Legislative~~
34 ~~Automated System Coordinator of said agency shall not exceed the maximum set~~
35 ~~forth herein.~~ Except for the purpose of determining the maximum annual salary
36 rate, which is to be applicable to each of the positions to which a salary

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1 grade is assigned hereinafter, in accordance with the provisions of Arkansas
 2 Code 21-5-209, all positions set forth herein shall be exempt from other
 3 provisions of the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act, or its
 4 successor, but shall not be exempt from the provisions of the Regular Salaries
 5 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or its successor.

SECTION 9. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TRANSFER PROVISION. Any unexpended balance of any appropriation provided in this Act which remains at the close of the fiscal year ending June 30, ~~1998~~ 2000, shall be transferred forward and made available for the same purpose for the fiscal year ending June 30, ~~1999~~ 2001. In the event that unforeseen circumstances arise during the fiscal year ending June 30, ~~1998~~ 2000 such that any appropriations made available for that year are insufficient, the Director of

25 SECTION 12. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
26 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. SENIOR
27 CAREER SERVICE POSITIONS. The positions authorized in Section 1 of this Act
28 as "Senior Career Service Positions" shall be utilized only for those
29 incumbents on June 30, 1997 who would otherwise be unable to obtain the same
30 pay increases available to other employees of the Bureau of Legislative
31 Research due to the exceptional tenure and circumstances of the incumbents.
32 In the event that the employee being paid from a "Senior Career Service
33 Position" is no longer employed by the Bureau of Legislative Research, the
34 position shall remain vacant. As long as any "Senior Career Service Position"
35 is filled, a position with the same title authorized as a regular employee in
36 Section 1 shall not be filled.

 2 SECTION 13. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS

 35 SECTION 19. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized
 36 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds

1 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the
 2 restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary
 3 Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures
 4 and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of

 30 SECTION 22. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
 31 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.
 32 ELECTRICITY DEREGULATION SET ASIDE. The Bureau of Legislative Research of the
 33 Legislative Council Disbursing Officer shall set aside \$50,000 of the
 34 appropriation provided in this act for Interim Committee Study Expenses for
 35 the purpose of paying the expenses incurred in obtaining the necessary
 36 resources to insure that residential consumer interests are evaluated in any

5 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas
6 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

8 SECTION 24. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this act or the application
9 thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall
10 not affect other provisions or applications of the act which can be given
11 effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the
12 provisions of this act are declared to be severable.

13
14 SECTION 25. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with
15 this act are hereby repealed.

16
17 SECTION 26. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the
18 Eighty-second General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas
19 prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that
20 the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 1999 is essential to the operation of
21 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
22 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective
23 date of this Act beyond July 1, 1999 could work irreparable harm upon the
24 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.
25 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being
26 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
27 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 1999, except
28 for Section 17 and Section 18 which shall be in full force and effect from and
29 after the date of passage and approval of this act.
