### **Subtitle**

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17 "AN ACT FOR THE DIVISION OF LEGISLATIVE  
18 AUDIT OF THE LEGISLATIVE JOINT AUDITING  
19 COMMITTEE SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION. "  
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22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
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24 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES. There is hereby established for the Division  
25 of Legislative Audit of the Legislative Joint Auditing Committee the following  
26 maximum number of regular employees which shall be supplemental and in  
27 addition to those positions authorized in Section 1 of Act 147 of 1997 and  
28 whose salaries shall be governed by the provisions of the Uniform  
29 Classification and Compensation Act (Arkansas Code §§21-5-201 et seq.), or its  
30 successor, and all laws amendatory thereto. Provided, however, that any  
31 position to which a specific maximum annual salary is set out herein in  
32 dollars, shall be exempt from the provisions of said Uniform Classification  
33 and Compensation Act. All persons occupying positions authorized herein are  
34 hereby governed by the provisions of the Regular Salaries Procedures and  
35 Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-101), or its successor.

SECTION 2. APPROPRIATION. There is hereby appropriated, to the Division of Legislative Audit of the Legislative Joint Auditing Committee, to be payable from the State Central Services Fund, for personal services of the Division of Legislative Audit of the Legislative Joint Auditing Committee which shall be supplemental and in addition to those funds appropriated in Section 3 of Act 147 of 1997, the following:

SECTION 3. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

SECTION 4. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by

1 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral  
2 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint  
3 Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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5 SECTION 5. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent  
6 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas  
7 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

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9 SECTION 6. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this act or the application  
10 thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall  
11 not affect other provisions or applications of the act which can be given  
12 effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the  
13 provisions of this act are declared to be severable.

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15 SECTION 7. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with  
16 this act are hereby repealed.

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18 SECTION 8. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the  
19 Eighty-second General Assembly, that funds provided by the General Assembly  
20 for the operations of the Division of Legislative Audit of the Legislative  
21 Joint Auditing Committee are, due to unforeseen circumstances, insufficient  
22 for the Division of Legislative Audit of the Legislative Joint Auditing  
23 Committee to continue to provide essential governmental services; that the  
24 provisions of this act will provide the necessary monies for the Division of  
25 Legislative Audit of the Legislative Joint Auditing Committee to continue such  
26 services; and that a delay in the effective date of this Act could work  
27 irreparable harm upon the proper administration and provision of essential  
28 governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and  
29 this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace,  
30 health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of  
31 its passage and approval.

32 If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor, it shall become  
33 effective on the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor  
34 may veto the bill. If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is  
35 overridden, it shall become effective on the date the last house overrides the  
36 veto.
