22	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 11-9-102 (12), concerning the definition of			
23	"employment" for purposes of the Workers' Compensation Law, is amended to read

All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code 25 26 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code. 27 28 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to 29 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without 30 31 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this 32 act are declared to be severable. 33 34 SECTION 4.
