- the mission of the commission to promote forest resource health, conservation, 1 2 and stewardship. The commission shall cooperate with federal and state 3 agencies, forest landowners, residents, and organizations in the prevention, detection, and suppression of wildland fires, in the control of forest insects 4 and diseases, in the growth and distribution of forest tree seedlings, and in 5 providing technical assistance and information relating to the most scientific 6 7 methods of timber harvesting, reforestation, forest resource protection and development, to the end that the forests throughout the State may be 8 9 perpetuated." 10 SECTION 2. Arkansas Code 15-31-102(a) is amended to read as follows: 12 "(a) The State Arkansas Forestry Commission shall consist of nine (9) members to be appointed by the Governor, by and with the advice and consent of 13

 - the Senate, from resident electors of this state having a long-standing interest in the industry as described in § 15-31-101 forest resources of Arkansas.
 - (1) Three (3) of the nine (9) members appointed to the commission shall be small tree farmers. As used in this section, 'small tree farmer' means a person owning timber acreage of two hundred fifty (250) acres or less.
 - Each congressional district shall be represented on the commission."

SECTION 3. Arkansas Code 15-31-106(a)(1) is amended to read as follows: "(1) Cooperate with the Secretary of Agriculture of the United States, or his the Secretary's authorized representative agent, with the College of Agriculture and School of Forest Resources of the University of Arkansas System, with the Arkansas Economic Development Commission, with other state agencies, and with the farmers, forest owners, and other residents or and organizations of the state to achieve the mission of the Arkansas Forestry Commission in the prevention and suppression of forest fires and in the control of forest insects and diseases; in the growing and distribution of forest planting stock; and in cooperation with the College of Agriculture of the University of Arkansas, in the gathering and dissemination of information concerning the growth, utilization, and renewal of forests; to the end that the forests throughout the state may be perpetuated; "
