#### Abstract

For An Act To Be Entitled "AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE TITLE 24, CHAPTER 7, SUBCHAPTER 2, REGARDI NG THE GENERAL PROVI SI ONS OF THE TEACHER RETI REMENT SYSTEM TO ESTABLI SH A PROVI SI ON FOR THE SUSPENSI ON OF BENEFIT PAYMENTS TO RETI RANTS UPON REQUEST; TO DECLARE AN EMERGENCY; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES. "


## Subtitle

> "TO ALLOW RETI RANTS OF THE TEACHER RETI REMENT SYSTEM TO ELECT TO SUSPEND BENEFI TS. "

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTI ON 1. Arkansas Code Title 24, Chapter 7, Subchapter 2, regarding the general provisions of the Teacher Retirement System is amended by adding the following section to be appropriatel y numbered by the Arkansas Code Revi si on Commi ssi on:
"Suspensi on of benefit payments upon request.
(a) Not wi thst andi ng any ot her provi si on of the system a person entitled to recei ve an annuity may request the system in writing, for personal reasons and without disclosure thereof, to suspend the payment of all the benefit ot herwi se payable to hi m by the system
(b) Upon recei pt of the request, the systemshall authorize the suspensi on, and the person shall be deemed to have forfeited all rights to the benefit so suspended but shall have the right to have the full benefit
ot herwi se payable reinstated as to fut ure mont hly payment upon written notice to the system to revoke the prior request for suspensi on under thi s section."

SECTI ON 2. No benefit enhancement provided for by this act shal l be i mplemented if it would cause the publicly supported retirement system s unf unded actuarial accrued liabilities to exceed a thirty (30) year amortization. No benefit enhancement provided for by this act shall be i mpl emented by any publ i cly supported system whi ch has unf unded act uari al accrued li abilities being amortized over a period exceeding thirty (30) years until the unf unded actuarial accrued liability is reduced to a level less than the standards prescribed by Arkansas Code, Title 24.

SECTI ON 3. All provisions of this act of a general and permant nature are amendat ory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revi si on Commi ssi on shall incorporate the same in the Code.

SECTI ON 4. If any provision of this act or the application ther eof to any person or circunstance is hel d i nvalid, such invalidity shall not affect ot her provisions or aplications of the act which can be given effect wi thout the inval id provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this act are decl ared to be severable.

SECTI ON 5. All I aws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are her eby repeal ed.

SECTI ON 6. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is her eby found and determined by the Ei ghty-second General Assembly that certain Teacher Retirement System retirants, for personal reasons whi ch they do not wish disclosed, may want to suspend thei $r$ benefits, that providing retirants with this option leaves the system open to question about liability for these suspended benefits and the law needs clarification i this situation, and that the most effective time to make changes to the retirement systemis at the beginning of the state's fiscal year and therefore this act should take effect imedi ately at that time. Ther ef ore, an emergency is decl ared to exi st and this act being i mredi at el $y$ necessary for the preservati on of the public peace, heal th and safety shall become effective on July 1, 1999.
