## Subtitle

20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
21

22 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES - GENERAL OPERATIONS. There is hereby  
23 established for the State Military Department for the 1999-2001 biennium, the  
24 following maximum number of regular employees whose salaries shall be governed  
25 by the provisions of the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act (Arkansas  
26 Code §§21-5-201 et seq.), or its successor, and all laws amendatory thereto.  
27 Provided, however, that any position to which a specific maximum annual salary  
28 is set out herein in dollars, shall be exempt from the provisions of said  
29 Uniform Classification and Compensation Act. All persons occupying positions  
30 authorized herein are hereby governed by the provisions of the Regular  
31 Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-101), or its  
32 successor.

SECTION 24. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. YOUTH CHALLENGE PROGRAM - STIPENDS. Juvenile participants in the Arkansas National Guard Youth Challenge Program at Camp Joseph T. Robinson receiving services from the Arkansas National Guard are authorized to receive a monetary stipend, not to exceed fifteen dollars (\$15.00) per week to defray personal hygiene and other personal necessities, and a monetary stipend not to exceed two thousand two hundred dollars (\$2,200) upon graduation from the program to defray costs for additional job training or education. 11 SECTION 28. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized

14 restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary  
15 Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures  
16 and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of  
17 this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of  
18 Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied

21 SECTION 29. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly  
22 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained

25 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by

34 SECTION 31. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this act or the application  
35 thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall  
36 not affect other provisions or applications of the act which can be given

1 effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the  
2 provisions of this act are declared to be severable.

3  
4 SECTION 32. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with  
5 this act are hereby repealed.

6  
7 SECTION 33. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the  
8 Eighty-second General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas  
9 prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that  
10 the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 1999 is essential to the operation of  
11 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in  
12 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective  
13 date of this Act beyond July 1, 1999 could work irreparable harm upon the  
14 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.  
15 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being  
16 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and  
17 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 1999.
