" 19 20 21 22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS: 23 24 SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION - STATEWIDE AND COMMUNITY NETWORKING. There is hereby appropriated, to the Department of Information Systems, to be payable 25 26 from the State General Services Fund Account, for planning and development of community-based computer network infrastructure for the biennial period ending 27 28 June 30, 2001, the sum of\$1,250,000. 29 SECTION 2. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE 30 NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. CARRY FORWARD. 31 32 The balance of the appropriation and funds made available in Section 1 herein which remains at the close of the fiscal year ending June 30, 2000 may be 33 carried forward and used for the same purpose in the next fiscal year. 34 35 SECTION 3. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized by 36

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- 1 this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds made
- 2 available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the restrictions
- 3 of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures
- 4 Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures and
- 5 Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this
- 6 State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of
- 7 Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied
- 8 with in disbursement of said funds.

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SECTION 4. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly 10 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained 11 12 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act 13 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations 14 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by 15 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral 16 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint 17 Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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SECTION 5. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

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SECTION 6. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this act are declared to be severable.

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SECTION 7. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are hereby repealed.

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SECTION 8. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the Eighty-Second General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 1999 is essential to the operation of the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in

- 1 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective
- 2 date of this Act beyond July 1, 1999 could work irreparable harm upon the
- 3 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.
- 4 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being
- 5 <u>necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and</u>
- 6 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 1999.
