26	SECTION 1. Arkans	sas Code 24-5-105(a) is amended to	o read as follows:	
27	"(a) The cost of	administering the plan shall be b	oorne by the Arkansas	
28	State Highway and Transportation Department, except that the Arkansas State			
29	Highway Employees' Retirement System shall pay the expenses incurred for the			
30	actuary, the consultant for investments, fees for the members of the medical

3	SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to		
4	any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect		
5	other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without		
6	the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this		
7	act are declared to be severable.		
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9	SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are		
10	hereby repeal ed.

12	SECTION 5. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the		
13	Eighty-second General Assembly that unless the accounting needs of the		
14	Arkansas State Highway Employees' Retirement System are immediately automated,		
15	delays could occur in preparing accurate financial statements and delays coul		
16	occur in the recording of investment transactions, which statements and		
17	recordings are required to be maintained by State and federal laws and		
18	regulations; that such delays could work irreparable harm upon the proper		
19	administration of essential governmental programs; and in order to avoid thes		
20	delays, this act should take effect immediately upon its passage and approval		
21	Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist and this act being immediately		
22	necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall		
23	become effective on the date of its approval by the Governor. If the bill is		
24	neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor, it shall become effective on the		
25	expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the bill.		
26	If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is overridden, it shall		
27	become effective on the date the last house overrides the veto.
