21	SECTION 1. <u>Defi</u>	initions. As used in this act:	
22	(1) "Healing art	ts" means the practice of any type o	f profession

SECTION 3. No person shall advertise or allow oneself to be advertised by the title "Doctor" in association with the practice of one of the healing arts, except in the practice of one of the health care professions regulated under Title 17 of the Arkansas Code, in which case that person shall use the title in accordance with the statutes and regulations governing the particular health care profession or unless that person has been granted a doctoral degree in any healing arts profession and is licensed in that profession under Title 17 of the Arkansas Code.

SECTION 4. In connection with the provision of health care services, no person shall call oneself or allow oneself to be called by the title "Doctor," except in the practice of one of the health care professions regulated under Title 17 of the Arkansas Code, in which case the person shall use the title in accordance with the statutes and regulations governing the particular health care profession.

SECTION 5. This act shall not be construed to authorize any person to use the title "Doctor", unless that title is authorized under Title 17 of the Arkansas Code, in which case that person shall use title in accordance with the statutes and regulations governing the particular health care profession or unless that person has been granted a doctoral degree in any healing arts profession and is licensed in that profession under Title 17 of the Arkansas Code.

SECTION 6. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

SECTION 7. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this act are declared to be severable.

SECTION 8. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
