## Subtitle

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTI ON 1. REGULAR SALARI ES - OPERATI ONS. There is her eby establ ished for the Henderson State Uni versity for the 1999-2001 bi enni um the following maxi mum number of regul ar empl oyees whose sal aries shall be governed by the provisions of the UniformCl assification and Compensation Act (Arkansas Code §§21-5-201 et seq.), or its successor, and all laws amendatory thereto. Provi ded, however, that any position to which a specific maximum annual sal ary is set out herein in dollars, shall be exempt fromthe provisions of said UniformCl assification and Compensation Act. All persons occupying positions authorized herei $n$ are hereby governed by the provisions of $t$ he Regul ar Sal aries Procedures and Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-101), or its successor.

SECTI ON 5. SPECI AL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE I NCORPORATED I NTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLI SHED SEPARATELY AS SPECI AL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW FOOD SERVI CE. If Henderson State Uni versity cancels the current contract for food service and chooses to operate the food service with Uni versity employees, the President, upon authorization of the Board of Trustees, is allowed to utilize the contingent positions contai ned in Section 1 of this Act, provided he or she has obtai ned approval fromthe Department of Higher Education and the Chi ef Fiscal Officer of the State, who has sought prior review by the Arkansas Legi slative Council.

SECTI ON 6. SPECI AL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE I NCORPORATED I NTO THE ARKANSAS CODE

NOR PUBLI SHED SEPARATELY AS SPECI AL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW SPECI AL ALLOWANCE. The Board of Trustees of Hender son St ate Uni versity may make special allowances available to any coach who coaches more than one sport in an amount not to exceed $\$ 5,000$ per year for any one coach during each year of the 1997-99 1999-2001 bi enni um Further, if the special allowance funds authorized her ei $n$ are utilized, Henderson State Uni versity shall report annually to the Legi slative $\quad$ oi nt Auditing Committee the exact di sposition of those special allowance funds.

SECTI ON 7. SPECI AL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE I NCORPORATED I NTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLI SHED SEPARATELY AS SPECI AL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW POSI TI ONS AND FUNDS RESTRI CTI ONS. None of the positions authorized or funds appropriated herei $n$ shall be used for the support of the Science Information Li ai son Of fice (SILO) program or its successor program or prograns. All assets and funds al located to the SI LO Programshall be transferred to the Bureau of Legi slative Research, to be used for research and constituency services for the 135 nembers of the Arkansas General Assently.

SECTI ON 8. COMPLI ANCE W TH OTHER LAVS. Di sbur sement of funds aut horized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds made available by I aw for the support of such appropriations; and the restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regul ar Sal ary Procedures and Restrictions Act, the Hi gher Education Expenditures Restrictions Act, or thei r successors, and ot her fiscal control laws of this State, where applicable, and regul ati ons promul gated by the Department of Fi nance and Admi ni stration, as authorized by I aw, shall be strictly complied with in di sbursement of said f unds.

SECTI ON 9. LEGI SLATI VE I NTENT. It i s the i nt ent of the General Assembly that any funds di sbursed under the authority of the appropriations cont ai ned in this act shal l be in compl iance with the stated reasons for whi ch this act was adopted, as evi denced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations and Legi sl ative Recommendations cont ai ned in the budget nanual s prepared by the Department of Fi nance and Admini stration, letters, or summarized or al testimony in the of ficial minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint

Budget Committee whi ch rel ate to its passage and adoption.

SECTI ON 10. CODE. Al I provisions of this Act of a gener al and permanent nat ure are amendat ory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annot at ed and the Arkansas Code Revisi on Comissi on shall incorporate the same in the Code.

SECTI ON 11. SEVERABI LITY. If any provi si on of this act or the application ther eof to any person or circumstance is hel dinvalid, such i nval idity shall not affect ot her provisions or applications of the act whi ch can be gi ven effect without the inval id provi si on or application, and to this end the provisions of this act are decl ared to be severable.

SECTI ON 12. GENERAL REPEALER. All I aws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are her eby repeal ed.

SECTI ON 13. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is her eby found and det er mined by the Ei ghty-second General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohi bits the appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 1999 is essential to the oper ation of the agency for whi ch the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in the event of an extensi on of the Regul ar Session, the del ay in the effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 1999 could work i rreparable harm upon the proper administration and provision of essential government al progran\$. Ther ef ore, an emergency is her eby decl ared to exi st and this Act bei ng necessary for the imedi ate preservation of the publ ic peace, heal th and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 1999.
