Liability of customer. 25 26 In the event the contractor fails to honor its financial obligations to the State of Arkansas, any city, county, school district, state agency, or other 27 political subdivision of the state, the customer for whom the work was being 28 29 performed shall be responsible for all financial obligations of the contractor to the State of Arkansas, or any city, county, school district, state agency, 30 31 or other political subdivision of the state, on that customer's project provided that the customer receives written notice of the contractor's failure 32 33 to comply with this subchapter prior to final payment to the contractor. The 34 written notice must include the maximum amount of any and all financial 35 obligations the contractor may potentially owe to the State of Arkansas, or any city, county, school district, state agency or other political subdivision 36

1	of the state, arising from that customer's project."

3	SECTION 2. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent nature
4	are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
5	Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

7	SECTION 3. If any provision of this Act or the application thereof to
8	any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
9	other provisions or applications of the Act which can be given effect without
10	the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
11	Act are declared to be severable.

13	SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are
14	hereby repealed.
