## For An Act To Be Entitled

9 "AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE 5-13-210 TO ADD A NEW  
10 SUBSECTION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

### Subtitle

12 "AN ACT TO ADD A NEW SUBSECTION TO  
13 INCLUDE THE OFFENSE OF THE INTRODUCTION  
14 OF A CONTROLLED SUBSTANCE INTO THE BODY  
15 OF ANOTHER TO PERPETRATE A SEXUAL  
16 OFFENSE."

20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
21

22 *SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 5-13-210, regarding the unlawful introduction*  
23 *of controlled substances into the body of another person, is amended to add an*  
24 *additional subsection to read as follows:*

25 "(f) Notwithstanding the provisions of subsection (c), any person who  
26 violates this section by introducing a controlled substance into the body of  
27 another person without their knowledge or consent with the purpose of  
28 committing any felonious sexual offense as defined under Arkansas law or with  
29 the purpose of engaging in any unlawful sexual act as defined in § 5-14-101  
30 through 123 or sexual contact as defined in § 5-14-101 or any act involving a  
31 child engaging in sexual explicit conduct as defined in § 5-27-302, is guilty  
32 of a Class Y felony."  
33

34 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature  
35 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code  
36 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this act are declared to be severable.

SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are hereby repealed.
