They shall be released only under and by the 26 direction of a court of competent jurisdiction or the prosecuting attorney 27 28 having criminal jurisdiction over the case. Provided, that nothing in this 29 section shall be construed to diminish the right of a defendant or his attorney to full access to all records pertaining to the case, and, provided 30 further, that the State Crime Laboratory shall disclose to a defendant or his 31 attorney all evidence in the defendant's case. 32 (2) However, a full report of the facts developed by the State 33 Medical Examiner or his assistants shall be promptly filed with the law 34 35 enforcement agencies, coroner, and prosecuting attorney of the jurisdiction in 36 which the death occurred.
