

5	(a) There is created and established a licensing committee to advise		
6	and assist the commission and department in the administration of the		
7	licensing program, which shall be composed of eight (8) members:		
8	(1) Five (5) members, to be appointed by the commission, of whi		
9	three (3) members shall be active wastewater treatment plant operators		
10	licensed by the department and two (2) members shall be employed by a private		
11	corporation or industry located in Arkansas and nominated at large by the		
12	corporations or industries for service on the committee;		
13	(2) One (1) member, to be appointed by the commission, shall be		
14	an employee of a municipality operating a wastewater treatment plant who holds		
15	the position of chief administrative officer, city engineer, director of		
16	public utilities, or other equivalent position;		
17	(3) One (1) member, to be appointed by the commission, shall be a		
18	faculty member of an accredited college, university, or professional school in		
19	the state whose major field is related to water resources or sanitary		
20	engi neeri ng; and		
21	(4) One (1) member shall be the Director of the Department of		
22	Pollution Control and Ecology, or a qualified member of his staff, who shall		
23	act as executive secretary of the licensing committee.		
24	(b)(1) In the event of a vacancy, a new member shall be appointed by		
25	the commission to serve out the unexpired term.		
26	(2) No member shall serve more than two (2) consecutive three-		
27	year terms.		
28	(c)(1) State agency members of the licensing committee shall receive no		
29	additional salary or per diem for their services as members of the committee,		
30	but they shall be allowed their travel and maintenance expenses while		
31	attending meetings away from Little Rock.		
32	(2) The members appointed by the commission shall be allowed per		
33	diem in accordance with law, plus their travel and maintenance expenses while		
34	attending meetings.

2 "8-5-204. Licensing committee. [As amended by Acts 1997, Nos. 250 and

4 (a)(1) There is created and established a licensing committee to advise
5 and assist the Arkansas Pollution Control and Ecology Commission <u>and the</u>
6 <u>Arkansas Department of Environmental Quality</u> in the administration of the
7 licensing program, <u>which</u>;

(2) Which shall be composed of eight (8) members:

9 (1)(A) Five (5) members, to be appointed by the commission,
10 of which three (3) members shall be active wastewater treatment plant
11 operators licensed by the commission and two (2) members shall be employed by
12 a private corporation or industry located in Arkansas and nominated at large
13 by the corporations or industries for service on the committee;

(2)(B) One (1) member, to be appointed by the commission,
 shall be an employee of a municipality operating a wastewater treatment plant
 who holds the position of chief administrative officer, city engineer,
 director of public utilities, or other equivalent position;

18 (3)(C) One (1) member, to be appointed by the commission,
 19 shall be a faculty member of an accredited college, university, or
 20 professional school in the state whose major field is related to water
 21 resources or sanitary engineering; and

22 (4)(D) One (1) member shall be the Director of the 23 Department of Pollution Control and Ecology, Arkansas Department of 24 Environmental Quality or a qualified member of his staff, who shall act as 25 executive secretary of the licensing committee.

(b)(1) In the event of a vacancy, a new member shall be appointed bythe commission to serve out the unexpired term.

28 (2) No member shall serve more than two (2) consecutive three-29 year terms.

30 (c)(1) State agency members of the licensing committee shall receive no
31 additional salary or per diem for their services as members of the committee,
32 but they may receive expense reimbursement in accordance with § 25-16-901 et
33 seq.

34 (2) The members appointed by the commission may receive expense
35 reimbursement and stipends in accordance with § 25-16-901 et seq."

1	SECTION 4. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature		
2	are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code		
3	Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

5	SECTION 5. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to		
6	any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect		
7	other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without		
8	the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this		
9	act are declared to be severable.

11	SECTION 6. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are		
12	hereby repealed.
