Arkansas Code Title 8 is amended to add the following new chapter to be appropriately numbered by the Arkansas Code Revision Commission: 23 24 "Title. This chapter may be known and may be cited as the 'Natural Resources 25 Damages Trust Fund Act. 26 27 28 Definitions. 29 As used in this chapter, unless the context otherwise requires: 30 (1) 'Advisory Board' means the Natural Resources Damages Advisory 31 Board; (2) 'Fund' means the Natural Resources Damages Trust Fund created by 32 33 this chapter; and (3) 'Natural resources' means land, fish, wildlife, biota, air, surface 34 water, ground water, drinking water supplies, and other such resources 35 belonging to, managed by, held in trust by, appertaining to, or otherwise 36

3	(a)(1) There is established on the books of the Treasurer of State,
4	Auditor of State, and Chief Fiscal Officer of the State a trust fund to be
5	known as the 'Natural Resources Damages Trust Fund.'
6	(2) In addition to all moneys appropriated by the General
7	Assembly to the fund, there shall be deposited in the fund all payments
8	collected by the state for restoration, rehabilitation, replacement, or
9	acquisition of natural resources and any moneys received by the state as a
10	gift or donation to the fund or any federal moneys designated to enter the
11	fund, and all interest earned upon moneys deposited in the fund.
12	(3) All moneys received into the fund shall be utilized for
13	natural resource restoration, rehabilitation, replacement, or acquisition.
14	(b) All expenditures from the fund shall be authorized by the Natural
15	Resources Damages Trust Advisory Board, according to the provisions of this
16	chapter and the requirements or conditions of any orders, settlement

20	There is hereby created and established a natural Resources Damages
21	Advisory Board.
22	(a) The Advisory Board shall be composed of seven (7) members:
23	(1) One (1) member shall be a representative from the Arkansas

25	(2) One (1) member shall be a representative from the Soil and
26	Water Conservation Commission;
27	(3) One (1) member shall be a representative from the Forestry

2	(c) The Advisory Board shall have the following powers and duties:

6	(3) To review and evaluate proposals for natural resource related

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14	Duties of the Department of Finance and Administration.
15	(a) The Department of Finance and Administration shall administer the

17	(b) The Department of Finance and Administration shall undertake the
18	following activities, as authorized by the Advisory Board:
19	(1) Develop and issue requests for proposals;
20	(2) Award grants for projects relating to natural resource
21	restoration, rehabilitation, replacement, and acquisition;
22	(3) Contract for services; and
23	(4) Make payments from the Natural Resources Damages Trust Fund. $^{\prime\prime}$
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25	SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
26	are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
27	Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.
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29	SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
30	any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
31	other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
32	the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
33	act are declared to be severable.
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35	SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
36	hereby repeal ed.
