" 21 22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS: 23 24 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 17-87-201 which creates and prescribes the 25 membership of the Arkansas State Board of Nursing, is amended by adding a new 26 subsection at the end thereof to read as follows: 27 28 "(k) In order to effectuate a more even staggering of the terms of nurse members of the board, the term of one (1) of the registered nurses whose 29 term will expire on October 1, 1999, is extended to October, 1, 2001, and the 30 31 term of the advanced practice nurse whose term will expire on October 1, 1999, is extended to October 1, 2002. The Governor shall designate the registered 32 nurse whose term is to be extended pursuant to this act. Thereafter, the 33 34 terms of all registered nurse and advanced practice nurse members shall be 35 four (4) years."
