23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

25 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 5-4-404 is amended to read as follows:

26 5-4-404. Credit for time spent in custody.

27 If a defendant is held in custody for conduct that results in a
28 sentence to imprisonment, or confinement as a condition of suspension or
29 probation, the court, the Department of Correction, or the Department of
30 Community Punishment shall credit the time spent in custody, including time
31 spent in a local jail facility awaiting transfer to the Department of
32 Correction or the Department of Community Punishment, against the sentence.
