22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

24 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 19-4-105 is amended to read as follows:
25 19-4-105. Continuing studies and investigations.

26 (a) The Chief Fiscal Officer of the State is directed to make
27 continuing studies and investigations of the operation of state agencies and
28 to make recommendations to the General Assembly, the Legislative Council, and
29 the Governor about improvements which should be made in order to:

- 30 (1) Safeguard against excessive expenditures of appropriations
31 and funds;
32 (2) Promote economy, efficiency, and control in the operation of
33 state agencies;
34 (3) Properly execute budgets; and
35 (4) Accomplish the purposes of this chapter as intended by the
36 General Assembly.
