Arkansas Code 27-50-408, concerning fines for speeding in a highway work zone, is amended to read as follows: 23 27-50-408. Fines for speeding moving traffic violations in a highway 24 25 work zone. (a) As used in this section, unless the context otherwise requires: 26 27 (1) "Highway work zone" means any area upon or adjacent to any highway, road, or street of this state where construction, reconstruction, 28 29 maintenance, or any other type of work is being performed or is in progress by employees of the Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department, the 30 31 counties or the municipalities of this state, or any contractors of the State 32 Highway Commission or the counties or municipalities; (2) "Conviction" means a person who is charged with a violation 33 of law and who pleads guilty or nolo contendere, is found guilty, or forfeits 34 a bond in lieu of a plea or trial; 35 36 (3) "Department" means the Arkansas State Highway and

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- 1 Transportation Department; and
- 2 (4) "Construction personnel" means employees of the Arkansas
- 3 State Highway and Transportation Department or the counties or the
- 4 municipalities of this state, or any contractors of the State Highway
- 5 Commission or the counties or municipalities.
- 6 (b)(1)(A) In addition to all fines and penalties otherwise provided by
- 7 law, after the conviction of any person for speeding in excess of the posted
- 8 speed limit through any moving traffic violation committed while the person
- 9 $\underline{\text{is driving through a}}$ highway work zone in this state and if construction
- 10 personnel were present in the highway work zone when the offense occurred,
- 11 the trial judge shall assess an additional fine or penalty equivalent to all
- 12 other fines and penalties imposed by law upon that person for speeding in
- 13 excess of the posted speed limit committing a moving traffic violation in the
- 14 hi ghway work zone.
- 15 (B) Any bond posted pursuant to a charge of speeding in
- 16 excess of the posted speed limit through any committing any moving traffic
- 17 <u>violation while in a highway work zone in this state shall be double the</u>
- 18 amount of the bond otherwise required for speeding in excess of the posted
- 19 speed limit.
- 20 (2)(A) All fines, penalties, and other amounts collected by any
- 21 court in this state as a result of this section shall be paid over by the
- 22 court clerk or the collecting official to the county treasurer or municipal
- 23 treasurer.
- 24 (B) All such amounts collected in county cases shall be
- 25 remitted to the county treasurer and all such amounts collected in municipal
- 26 cases shall be remitted to the municipal treasurer.
- 27 (C) Amounts received by the county treasurer may be used
- 28 for general county purposes and amounts received by the municipal treasurer
- 29 may be used for general municipal purposes.
- 30 (c)(1) The additional fines and penalties shall not be assessed unless
- 31 signs, either permanent or temporary, were present at the time of the
- 32 violation in advance of the highway work zone warning the traveling public
- that fines are double in highway work zones.
- 34 (2) The signs shall be located no greater than one (1) mile nor
- 35 less than one thousand five hundred feet (1,500') in advance of the highway
- 36 work zone.

1	(3) Further, the additional fines or penalties for speeding				
2	shall not be assessed unless signs, either permanent or temporary, are posted				
3	in advance of the highway work zone indicating the maximum speed limit to be				
4	obeyed while traveling through the highway work zone.				
5	(4)(A) All signs authorized by this section shall conform with				
6	the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices.				
7	(B) The counties and municipalities, prior to utilizing				
8	any such signs, shall seek the advice of the Arkansas State Highway and				
9	Transportation Department in order that such signs shall be uniform				
10	throughout the state.				
11	(C) The department is authorized to develop guidelines for				
12	the counties and municipalities to achieve such uniformity.				
13	(d) Nothing contained in this section shall be construed to abrogate				
14	any of the provisions of § 12-8-106 regarding the powers of the Department of				
15	Arkansas State Police.				
16	(e) For purposes of this act, "moving traffic violation" shall				
17	<u>include, but not be limited to:</u>				
18	(1) Careless or prohibited driving;				
19	(2) Driving while intoxicated;				
20	(3) Underage driving under the influence;				
21	(4) Refusal to submit;				
22	(5) Leaving the scene of an accident;				
23	(6) Driving with lights off;				
24	(7) Driving on an expired, suspended or revoked license;				
25	(8) Improper use of lighting equipment;				
26	(9) Failure to obey traffic control devices and signs;				
27	(10) Failure to operate vehicle in accordance with "Rules of the				
28	<u>Road";</u>				
29	(11) Failure to stop and render aid;				
30	(12) Following too closely;				
31	(13) Driving the wrong way on a one way;				
32	<u>(14) Hazardous dri vi ng;</u>				
33	(15) Impeding the flow of traffic;				
34	(16) Improper backing;				
35	(17) Improper Lane change;				
36	(18) Improper entrance or exit to avoid intersection:
