## For An Act To Be Entitled

10 AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE 1-5-106, CONCERNING  
11 MEMORIAL DAYS IN ARKANSAS, TO ADD DECEMBER 19 OF  
12 EACH YEAR AS SENATOR HATTIE W. CARAWAY DAY; AND  
13 FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

23 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 1-5-106 is amended to read as follows:  
24 1-5-106. Memorial days generally.

25 The following days shall not be legal holidays but shall be memorial  
26 days to be commemorated by the issuance of appropriate proclamations by the  
27 Governor:

- 28 (1) General Douglas MacArthur Day - January 26th;
- 29 (2) Abraham Lincoln's Birthday - February 12th;
- 30 (3) Arkansas Teachers' Day - First Tuesday in March;
- 31 (4) Arbor Day - Third Monday in March;
- 32 ~~(4)~~(5) Patriots' Day - April 19th;
- 33 ~~(5)~~(6) Arkansas Bird Day - April 26th;
- 34 ~~(6)~~(7) Good Friday - Friday preceding Easter;
- 35 ~~(7)~~(8) Jefferson Davis' Birthday - June 3rd;
- 36 ~~(8)~~(9) Columbus Day - October 12th;

1 ~~(9) Arbor Day — Third Monday in March~~

2 (10) Senator Hattie W. Caraway Day - December 19.
