Arkansas Code 13-5-704 is amended to read as follows: 23 24 13-5-704. Delta Cultural Center Policy Advisory Board. 25 (a) There is hereby created the Delta Cultural Center Policy Advisory 26 Board which shall advise the director and staff of the Delta Cultural Center on the development of permanent and temporary exhibits, a plan for aquisition 27 28 acquisition of resource materials, and development of educational and other 29 programmi ng. (b)(1) The board shall consist of nine (9) eleven (11) members. 30 31 (2)(A) The members shall be appointed by the Governor. The 32 members appointed by the Governor shall be subject to confirmation by the 33 Senate. The Governor shall make his appointments in such a manner that each race or ethnic group having a significant presence in the Delta region shall 34 35 be adequately represented on the board. 36 (B) The board members to be appointed by the Governor

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1	shall be:
2	(i) Two (2) residents of Phillips County who have
3	exhibited an interest in the culture and heritage of the Delta;
4	(ii) A Delta blues musician;
5	(iii) Two (2) members to serve as academic advisors
6	who shall be training in the field of Delta folklore, history, or a related
7	field;
8	(iv) A member of the Board of the Arkansas Endowment
9	for the Humanities; and
10	(v) Three (3) members at large-; and
11	(vi) Two (2) members as representatives of Main
12	Street Helena.
13	(3) The board shall meet at least quarterly. Special
14	meetings may be called by the chairman or a majority of the board.
15	(c)(1) The members of the board appointed by the Governor shall serve
16	for three-year terms.
17	(2) No member of the board shall be eligible for appointment to
18	more than two (2) consecutive full terms.
19	(d) The chairman will be elected by members for a one-year term.
20	(e) Any vacancy in the membership of the board other than by the
21	expiration of the term of office shall be filled by the Governor for the
22	balance of the term of the membership which became vacant.
23	(f) The members of the board shall receive no compensation for their
24	services, but they may receive expense reimbursement in accordance with § 25-
25	16-901 et seq.
