(a) The Board of Correction and Community Punishment may 23 promulgate rules and regulations to allow inmates to participate in a 24 25 meritorious furlough program which include a requirement that the sheriff of 26 the county and the chief of police of the city or town, if applicable, shall be notified if an inmate will be present within their jurisdiction while on 27 28 furl ough. 29 (b) The rules and regulations referred to in subsection (a) of this section shall not require the sheriff of the county, or the chief of police 30 31 of the city or town, if applicable, of the jurisdiction in which an inmate will be present on furlough, to approve the granting of the furlough. 32 33 (c) All Arkansas certified law enforcement officers are authorized to escort inmates on emergency furlough. 34 (d) The Board of Correction and Community Punishment may promulgate 35 rules and regulations necessary to implement subsection (c) of this section. 36
