### Subtitle

14 TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE 14-15-205  
15 CONCERNING SENIOR APPRAISERS.

18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
19

20 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 14-15-205(b)(1), concerning senior  
21 appraisers, is amended to read as follows:

22 (b)(1)(A)(i) County assessors and their employees designated as Senior  
23 (Level 4) Appraisers by the Assessment Coordination ~~Division of the Public~~  
24 Service Commission Department shall, to the extent moneys are available,  
25 annually receive a professional development recognition payment in an amount  
26 not to exceed five hundred dollars (\$500).

27 (ii) County assessors and their employees designated  
28 as Senior (Level 4) Appraiser Managers by the Assessment Coordination  
29 Department shall, to the extent moneys are available, annually receive a  
30 professional development recognition payment in an amount not to exceed seven  
31 hundred and fifty dollars (\$750).

32 (B) A Senior (Level 4) Appraiser, with four (4) years of  
33 appraisal experience may serve as an appraisal or reappraisal manager in a  
34 county if the appraiser complies with the standards established by the  
35 Assessment Coordination Department.
