APPROPRIATION - DISTRIBUTION OF HIV/AIDS MEDICATIONS. There is 24 25 hereby appropriated, to the Department of Health, to be payable from the 26 General Improvement Fund or its successor fund or fund accounts, for the 27 distribution of HIV/AIDS medications to Arkansas citizens without ample 28 resources or available avenues to acquire the medications by the Department of 29 Health for the biennial period ending June 30, 2003, the sum of 30 31 32 SECTION 2. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. CARRY FORWARD. 33 At the close of the fiscal year ending June 30, 2002, any unexpended balance 34 35 of monies provided for in Section 1 of this Act, shall be transferred forward and made available for the same purpose for the fiscal year ending June 30, 36

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1 2003. The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2001 2 through June 30, 2003. 3 4 SECTION 3. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized by 5 this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds made 6 available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the restrictions 7 of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures and 8 9 Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of 10 11 Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied 12 with in disbursement of said funds. 13 SECTION 4. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly 14 15 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained 16 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act 17 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations 18 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by 19 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral 20 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint 21 Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption. 22 23 SECTION 5. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the Eighty-third General Assembly, that the citizens of Arkansas suffering from 24 25 HIV/AIDS should have access to the latest drug therapies; that the continued 26 spread of HIV is a danger to the public health of Arkansas; that proper treatment of individuals living with HIV/AIDS who are pregnant can 27 significantly decrease the possibility of infecting their unborn child; that 28 29 infection rates among Arkansas citizens can be curtailed by the proper 30 administration of drug therapies to those infected with HIV/AIDS; the 31 continued medical costs associated with HIV related illnesses is a threat to 32 the medical infrastructure of Arkansas; and that the quality of life of those 33 individuals affected by HIV/AIDS, along with their family members, can be enhanced. Further, there is a pressing and immediate need for the distribution 34

of medications as described herein, that this act has as its purpose the

furnishing of financial assistance to meet this need. Therefore, an emergency
