22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

24 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 16-10-307(c)(1) is amended to read as follows:

25 (c)(1) The county administration of justice fund of each county may
26 retain an amount equal to the amount which was collected by the county from
27 court costs and filing fees for county administration of justice expense in
28 the calendar year ending December 31, 1994, or the amount appropriated from
29 court costs and filing fees by ordinance enacted prior to December 31, 1994,
30 or on February 13, 1995, or on February 14, 1995, or by resolution dated
31 February 9, 1995, for county administration of justice expense from court
32 costs and filing fees for the calendar year ending December 31, 1995, plus,
33 for ~~each year after~~ calendar ~~year~~ years 1995 through 2001, an additional
34 amount based upon the average percentage increase in the Consumer Price Index
35 for All Urban Consumers or its successor, as published by the United States
36 Department of Labor for the two (2) years immediately preceding. The amount

1 retained during calendar year 2002 and each calendar year thereafter shall be
2 the amount retained during calendar year 2001.

5 SECTION 2. Arkansas Code 16-10-308(c)(1) is amended to read as follows:

6 (c)(1) The city administration of justice fund of each city may retain
7 an amount equal to the amount which was collected by the city from court costs
8 and filing fees for city administration of justice expense in the calendar
9 year ending December 31, 1994, or the amount appropriated from court costs and
10 filing fees by ordinance enacted prior to December 31, 1994, for city or
11 county administration of justice expense from court costs and filing fees for
12 the calendar year ending December 31, 1995, plus, for ~~each year after~~ calendar
13 ~~year~~ years 1995 through 2001, an additional amount based upon the average
14 percentage increase in the Consumer Price Index for All Urban Consumers or its
15 successor, as published by the United States Department of Labor for the two
16 (2) years immediately preceding. The amount retained during calendar year 2002
17 and each calendar year thereafter shall be the amount retained during calendar
18 year 2001.
