Arkansas Code 19-10-204 is amended to read as follows: 19-10-204. Juri sdi cti on. 24 25 (a) Except as otherwise provided by law, the Arkansas State Claims 26 Commission shall have exclusive jurisdiction over all claims against the State 27 of Arkansas and its several agencies, departments, and institutions but shall have no jurisdiction of claims against municipalities, counties, school 28 districts, or any other political subdivisions of the state. 29 (b)(1) The commission shall have no jurisdiction of, or authority with 30 31 respect to, claims arising under the Workers' Compensation Law, § 11-9-101 et seq., the Employment Security Law, § 11-10-101 et seq., the Arkansas Teacher 32 Retirement System Act, § 24-7-201 et seq., the Arkansas Public Employees' 33 Retirement System Act, § 24-4-101 et seq., the State Police Retirement System 34 Act, § 24-6-201 et seg., or under laws providing for old age assistance 35 grants, child welfare grants, blind pensions, or any laws of a similar nature. 36

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1	Additionally, the commission shall have no jurisdiction over claims against
2	the state for repayment of child support, except in cases where the underlying
3	support order is set aside as void ab initio by the court and the child
4	support paid was retained by the state as reimbursement for public assistance
5	paid on behalf of a child. Claims solely addressing the receipting,
6	processing, and reissuance of child support payments through the Arkansas
7	Child Support Clearinghouse shall remain within the jurisdiction of the
8	commi ssi on.
9	(2)(A) The commission shall only have jurisdiction over those
10	claims which are barred by the doctrine of soverign immunity from being
11	litigated in a court of general jurisdiction.
12	(B) The commission shall have no jurisdiction over claims
13	for state tax refunds under § 26-18-507, claims challenging tax assessments
14	under § 26-18-406, and claims challenging tax laws under Article 16, Section
15	13, Constitution of the State of Arkansas.
16	(3) The commission shall make no award for any claim which, as a
17	matter of law, would be dismissed from a court of law or equity for reasons
18	other than sovereign immunity. Specifically, if the facts of a given claim
19	would cause the claim to be dismissed as a matter of law from a court of
20	general jurisdiction, then the commission shall make no award on the claim
21	(c) The commission shall have jurisdiction over actions to contest
22	eligibility, qualification, or election to serve as a member of the House of
23	Representatives of the General Assembly, for the purpose of making a
24	nonbinding recommendation thereon to that chamber of the General Assembly.
