Arkansas Code 19-5-205(e)(1)(B) is amended by adding the 19 following new subdivisions to reflect sources of income to the State Central 20 21 Services Fund to read as follows: (xiv) Public defender attorney fees to be used solely to defray costs 22 for the Arkansas Public Defender Commission as set out in §5-4-303(i)(2)(A). 23 (xv) Public defender user fees to be used to defray the costs of the 24 public defender system, §16-87-213. 25 26 SECTION 2. Arkansas Code 19-5-302(10)(B), concerning sources of funds 27 for the State General Services Fund Account, is amended to read as follows: 28 29 The fund account shall consist of: (i) Those general revenues as may be provided by law; 30 31 (ii) Those special revenues as set out in subdivision (125) of § 19-6-301 of 32 the Revenue Classification Law, § 19-6-301 et seq.; 33 (ii) Nonrevenue income derived from services provided by the various agencies and programs funded from the State General Services Fund Account; 34 35 and 36 (iv) (iii)(a) Federal reimbursement received on account of eligible

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- expenditures of the various agencies and programs receiving primary support from the State General Services Fund Account.
 - (b) In the event there are not sufficient funds available in the State General Services Fund Account to support the amounts appropriated from the State General Services Fund Account, the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State shall determine the amount of moneys to be made available for each of the appropriations made from the account.

- 27 (b)(1) This fund shall consist of those fees as set out in Title 17, Chapter
- 28 86, Subchapter 2.
- 29 (2) The fund shall be used for the administration and expenses of the Massage
- 30 Therapy Board as set out in Title 17, Chapter 86, Subchapter 2.

- 32 SECTION 18. Arkansas Code 19-7-503, concerning the receipt of
- 33 unanticipated federal funds, is amended to read as follows:

- 18 other programs approved by the federal government for which no appropriations
- 19 or insufficient appropriations were provided elsewhere for such purposes;
- 20 (3) Additional positions authorized under the provisions of § 19-7-502 must
- 21 be paid from Comprehensive Employment and Training Workforce Investment Act,
- 22 or its successor's, funds deposited in the State Treasury for that specific
- 23 Comprehensive Employment and Training Workforce Investment Act, or its
- 24 successor's, program as may be authorized through the provisions of this
- 25 subchapter or from federal, local, or private funds deposited in the State
