16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

18 SECTION 1. (a) This act shall be known and may be cited as the "The
19 Arkansas School Children Protection Act".

20 (b) For purposes of this act:

21 (1) A sexual offense is one described in Arkansas Code Title 5,
22 Chapter 14, Subchapter 1; and

23 (2) "Conviction" means having pled guilty or nolo contendere to,
24 or having been found guilty of, committing a sexual offense against a minor.

25 (c) Any public school district employee who commits a sexual offense
26 against a minor shall, upon conviction, be dismissed from employment and
27 shall not thereafter be eligible for employment by any school in this state.
