SECTION 3. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. 24 <u>SECTION 4. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General</u> 25 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the 26 appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the 27 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2001 is essential to the operation of the 28 agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in the 29 event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective date 30 of this Act beyond July 1, 2001 could work irreparable harm upon the proper
