Arkansas Code 3-5-205(f), concerning the home manufacture 23 of beer, is amended to read as follows: (f)(1) However, any person in this state may manufacture home-brewed 24 25 beer or home manufactured wine: 26 (A) Upon his or her own premises free from the license 27 fees and taxes provided in this subchapter; (B) For consumption by the manufacturer and his or her 28 family and guests, but not for sale; 29 (C) In quantities not to exceed two hundred (200) gallons 30 31 per calendar year if there are two (2) or more adults in such household, or one hundred (100) gallons if there is only one (1) adult in such household. 32 33 (2) While the manufacture of beer or wine is declared to be a privilege, the home manufacture of beer or wine in quantities not to exceed 34 35 two hundred (200) gallons per calendar year shall be exempted from §§ 3-4-36 101, 3-4-602, 3-5-205(a)-(e), 3-5-206, and 3-5-211.

2	SECTION 2. Arkansas Code 3-5-207(b), concerning the home manufacture
3	of beer, is amended to read as follows:
4	(b) No permit shall be required for the home manufacture of beer <u>or</u>
5	wine in quantities not to exceed two hundred (200) gallons per calendar year
6	under §§ 3-4-101, 3-4-602, 3-5-206, or 3-5-211, as may otherwise be required
7	of other manufacturers.
8	
9	SECTION 3. Arkansas Code 3-5-210(b), concerning the home manufacture
10	of beer, is amended to read as follows:
11	(b) Home manufacturers of beer <u>or wine</u> in quantities not to exceed two
12	hundred (200) gallons per year shall be exempt as provided in §§ 3-5-
13	205(f)(2) and $3-5-207(b)$ from the permit requirements for the manufacture of
14	beer <u>and wine</u> and shall not be prosecuted for brewing or manufacturing beer
15	<u>or wine</u> without a permit.
