Stricken language would be deleted from and underlined language would be added to the law as it existed prior to this session of the General Assembly.

    SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 16-21-137 is amended to read as follows:
    16-21-137. The Fifteenth Judicial District.
    The Fifteenth Judicial District shall be a Division A \(\underline{B}\) Judicial
    District.

SECTION 2. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the Eightythird General Assembly that the Fifteenth Judicial District would operate more effectively with a Class B prosecutor in that it is no longer necessary for
the Prosecuting Attorney to continue as a full time prosecutor. Therefore, an
emergency is declared to exist and this act being immediately necessary for
the preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall become effective
on the date of its approval by the Governor. If the bill is neither approved
nor vetoed by the Governor, it shall become effective on the expiration of the

period of time during which the Governor may veto the bill. If the bill i s
vetoed by the Governor and the veto is overridden, it shall become effective
on the date the last house overrides the veto.
