## For An Act To Be Entitled

10 AN ACT TO ENSURE THE CONTINUED DISTRIBUTION BY THE  
11 ARKANSAS DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH OF HIV/AIDS MEDICATION  
12 TO ARKANSAS CITIZENS WITHOUT AMPLE RESOURCES OR  
13 AVAILABLE AVENUES TO ACQUIRE MEDICATIONS; AND FOR  
14 OTHER PURPOSES.

### Subtitle

16 AN ACT TO ENSURE THE CONTINUED  
17 DISTRIBUTION BY THE ARKANSAS DEPARTMENT  
18 OF HEALTH OF HIV/AIDS MEDICATION TO

25 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

27 SECTION 1. TITLE.

28 This act shall be known and may be cited as the "HIV/AIDS Medications  
29 Act of 2001".

31 SECTION 2. PURPOSE.

32 It is found and determined by the General Assembly that:

33 (1) The citizens of Arkansas suffering from HIV/AIDS should have access  
34 to the latest drug therapies;

35 (2) The continued spread of HIV is a danger to the public health of  
36 Arkansas;
