19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

21 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 28-1-112(c)(1) is amended to read as follows:

22 (c)(1) By Whom Prepared, Signed, and Served. Except when by statute or
23 by order of the court otherwise expressly provided, a notice in a probate
24 proceeding shall be in writing or print and prepared by or by procurement of
25 the party upon whom rests the burden of giving the notice and shall be signed
26 by the clerk or the attorney for the party upon whom rests the burden of
27 giving notice. If service is to be by mail, the person preparing the notice
28 shall sign it or deliver it to the clerk properly prepared for the clerk's
29 signature.
