Stricken language would be deleted from and underlined language would be added to the law as it existed prior to this session of the General Assembly.

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 1-5-101(a), concerning official holidays, is amended to read as follows:
(a) The following days are declared to be the sole official holidays applicable to state government in Arkansas:
(1) New Year's Day - January 1;
(2) Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr.'s Birthday and Robert E. Lee's Birthday - the third Monday in January;
(3) George Washington's Birthday and Daisy Gatson Bates Day - the third Monday in February;
(4) Memorial Day - the last Monday in May;
(5) Independence Day - July 4;
(6) Labor Day - the first Monday i n September;
(7) Veterans Day - November 11;
(8) Thanksgiving Day - the fourth Thursday in November;
(9) Christmas Eve - December 24;
(10) Christmas Day - December 25 ;
(11) The employee's birthday - employee is granted one (1)
holiday to observe his or her birthday.
