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27	SECTION 1. Purp	00SE			
28	(a) Gamma-hydroxybutyrate ("GHB") was not scheduled as a controlled			<u>1</u>	
29	substance by the Federal Drug Enforcement Administration or by the Director o			or of	
30	the Arkansas Department of Health prior to 1999. Concerned about the				
31	potential for the substance's abuse, the Eighty-second General Assembly				
32	designated GHB as a Schedule VI controlled substance.				
33	(b) Subsequently, the Drug Enforcement Administration classified GHB a			∄B as	
34	a Schedule I. In addition, the final rule of the Drug Enforcement				
35	Administration places Food and Drug Administration approved products				
36	containing GHB into Schedule III, if or when they are approved.				

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1	(c) Since the legislature classified GHB as a schedule VI substance,		
2	the Director was precluded from scheduling GHB in a manner consistent with th		
3	scheduling designated by the Drug Enforcement Administration. As a result,		
4	criminal sanctions for the possession with the intent to deliver GHB are not		
5	as severe as other substances possessing similar harmful and abusive		
6	<u>characteri sti cs.</u>		
7	(d) It is the purpose of this act to allow the director to adopt the		
8	Drug Enforcement Administration's scheduling of GHB pursuant to Arkansas Code		
9	<u>5-64-201.</u>

11	SECTION 2. Arkansas Code 5-64-201 is amended by adding the following		
12	additional subsection:		
13	(f) The director shall schedule gamma-hydroxybutyrate and its known		
14	precursors and analogs in a manner consistent with the procedures outlined in		
15	<u>this section.</u>		
16			
17	SECTION 3. Arkansas Code 5-64-215(b), (c) and (d), concerning Schedule		
18	VI controlled substances, are amended to read as follows:		
19	(b) Gamma-hydroxybutyrate; also known as GHB, gamma-hydroxybutyric		
20	acid, sodium oxybate, sodium oxybutyrate, gamma-hydroxybutyrate sodium, gamma		
21	OH, 4-hydroxybutyrate, gamma-hydrate, somatomax PM, somasnit, and gamma-		
22	hidroxibutirato; is hereby designated a Schedule VI drug. The Director of the		
23	Department of Health shall amend the Schedule VI list of controlled substances		
24	to include gamma hydroxybutyrate as a Schedule VI drug, and it shall remain a		
25	Schedul e VI drug.		
26	(c)(b) Provided, that the director shall not delete the controlled		
27	substances listed in this section from Schedule VI.		
28	(d) Nothing in this section shall prohibit a physician from prescribing		
29	the drug gamma-hydroxybutyrate, if the physician is authorized to prescribe		
30	gamma-hydroxybutyrate under specific Federal Drug Administration exemptions		
31	for investigational research protocols.

33	SECTION 3. Arkansas Code 5-64-413(a)(1) is amended to read as follows:		
34	(a)(1) "Controlled substance analog" means a substance the chemical		
35	structure of which is substantially similar to the chemical structure of a		
36	controlled substance in Schedule I or II and <u>or</u> which has a stimulant,		

1	depressant, or hallucinogenic effect on the central nervous system		
2	substantially similar to the stimulant, depressant, or hallucinogenic effect		
3	on the central nervous system of a controlled substance included in Schedule		
4	or II; or with respect to a particular individual, which the individual		
5	represents or intends to have a stimulant, depressant, or hallucinogenic		
6	effect on the central nervous system substantially similar to the stimulant,		
7	depressant, or hallucinogenic effect on the central nervous system of a		
8	controlled substance included in Schedule I or II.
