BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 12-12-1010(b), concerning the dissemination of criminal history information, is amended to read as follows:
(b) (1) Criminal history information shall be made available according to the provisions of the National Crime Prevention and Privacy Compact
following the adoption of such compact by the General Assembly.
(2) (A) The Arkansas General Assembly approves and ratifies the National Crime Prevention and Privacy Compact, 42 U.S.C. § 14616, as it existed on لanuary 1, 2001, and the compact shall remain in effect until legislation is enacted renouncing the compact.
(B) The Director of the Arkansas Crime Information Center, the repository of criminal history records, shall execute, administer, and
implement the compact on behalf of the state, and may adopt necessary rules,
regulations, and procedures for the national exchange of criminal history
records for noncriminal justice purposes.
(C) Ratification of the compact does not affect the
obligations and responsibilities of the Arkansas Crime Information Center
