Arkansas Code 12-8-106(c), concerning duties of the Arkansas 25 26 State Police, is amended to read as follows: 27 (c) The Department of Arkansas State Police shall have the authority to establish a Family Protection Unit Crimes Against Children Division, either 28 through transfer or by contract, to conduct child abuse investigations, to 29 administer the child abuse hotline, and, when consistent with regulations 30 31 promulgated by the Department of Arkansas State Police, to provide training 32 and technical assistance to local law enforcement in conducting child abuse 33 investigations. 34 SECTION 2. Arkansas Code 12-8-501, concerning the Arkansas State Police 35 Family Protection Unit, is amended to read as follows: 36

1 12-8-501. Legislative intent.

The General Assembly recognizes that the state has a responsibility to provide competent and thorough child abuse investigations which are sensitive to the needs of children and families; that it is difficult for caseworkers with the *Division of Youth Services of the* Department of Human Services, which is currently charged with the responsibilities of investigating child abuse and providing services to children and families, to separate their dual roles as investigators and service providers; that many studies show that child abuse investigations are compromised when these very different functions are not separated; that child abuse is a crime and suspected child abuse should be investigated with due diligence by trained law enforcement officers.

Therefore, it is declared to be the intent of this General Assembly to authorize the Department of Arkansas State Police to create a Family Protection Unit Crimes Against Children Division, either through transfer or by contract, to conduct investigations into severe child abuse as defined by

SECTION 3. Arkansas Code 12-8-502, concerning the Arkansas State Police Family Protection Unit, is amended to read as follows:

interagency agreement and to administer the child abuse hotline.

12-8-502. Transfer of powers and duties - Sections of unit - Sharing of information.

- (a) When the powers and duties of the Department of Human Services in regard to the child abuse hotline and child abuse investigations are transferred to the Department of Arkansas State Police, or when the Department of Human Services and the Department of Arkansas State Police contract for the administration of the child abuse hotline or for the Department of Arkansas State Police to conduct child abuse investigations or both, the Department of Arkansas State Police shall establish a Family Protection Unit Crimes Against Children Division.
- (b) The Family Protection Unit Crimes Against Children Division shall consist of three (3) sections:
- (1) The Law Enforcement Child Abuse Section, which shall be staffed with law enforcement personnel and shall be responsible for the investigation of allegations that initially appear to involve severe child abuse or any other types of criminal child abuse;
 - (2) The Child and Family Protection Section, which shall be

staffed with non-law enforcement personnel and shall be responsible for the investigation of allegations of child abuse that initially do not appear to involve severe abuse or the need for a criminal investigation but have implications of criminal activity involving child abuse; and

- (3) The Child Abuse Hotline Section, which shall administer twenty-four-hour toll-free in-watts telephone services to report to the Department of Arkansas State Police information regarding possible incidents of child abuse.
- (c)(1) The Family Protection Unit Crimes Against Children Division shall develop and maintain statewide statistics regarding the incidence of child abuse.
- (2) Each county and city law enforcement agency conducting child abuse investigations through referral from the child abuse hotline shall report the status and disposition of these investigations to the Family Protection Unit Crimes Against Children Division on a monthly basis.
- (d)(1) If the powers and duties of the Department of Human Services in regard to the child abuse hotline and child abuse investigations are transferred to the Department of Arkansas State Police, the Family Protection Unit Crimes Against Children Division of the Department of Arkansas State Police and the Division of Youth Services of the Department of Human Services shall enter into a memorandum of understanding that shall include provisions that address the sharing of information reported to the child abuse hotline with the Division of Youth Services Department of Human Services when such information is necessary for the division to provide appropriate service delivery to children and families.
- (2) If the Department of Human Services and the Department of Arkansas State Police contract for the administration of the child abuse hotline or for the Department of Arkansas State Police to conduct child abuse investigations, or both, the contract shall include provisions that address the sharing of information reported to the child abuse hotline with the *Division of Youth Services Department of Human Services* when such information is necessary for the division to provide appropriate service delivery to children and families.

SECTION 4. Arkansas Code 29-30-148(5), concerning membership of the Arkansas Crime Victims Advisory Board, is amended to read as follows:
