(a) It is unlawful to use any camera, videotape, photo-optical, photo-20 21 electric, or any other image recording device for the purpose of secretly 22 observing, viewing, photographing, filming, or videotaping a person present 23 in a residence, place of business, school, or other structure, or any room or particular location within that structure, where that person is in a private 24 25 area out of public view, has a reasonable expectation of privacy, and has not 26 consented to the observation. (b) A violation of this section is a Class D felony. 27 (c) The provisions of this section shall not apply to any of the 28 29 following: (1) Video recording or monitoring conducted pursuant to a court 30 31 order from a court of competent jurisdiction; 32 (2) Security monitoring operated by or at the direction of an 33 occupant of a residence; (3) Security monitoring operated by or at the direction of the 34 35 owner or administrator of a place of business, school, or other structure; 36 (4) Security monitoring operated in motor vehicles used for
