Arkansas Code 6-17-907(I), which provides the funds to be 26 established by the county treasurer for each school district, is amended to 27 read as follows: (I) When a school district has a district treasurer, the county 28 29 treasurer may establish for that district only those the fund or funds needed to credit the types of revenues flowing through his office properly note 30 31 revenues received for the school district and disbursements made to the school 32 di stri ct. 33 SECTION 2. Arkansas Code 6-17-907, which provides the funds to be 34 35 established by the county treasurer for each school district, is amended by 36 adding an additional subsection to read as follows:

I	(III)(1) IT a school district uses a computerized accounting system that
2	properly segregates revenues and disbursements by type and fund in accordance
3	with state law and the Division of Legislative Audit requirements, the school
4	district may request that the county treasurer, serving as school treasurer,
5	receive and disburse all funds from one (1) operating account.
6	(2) The request shall be made in writing by the superintendent of
7	the school district to the county treasurer.
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9	SECTION 3. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
10	Assembly that the revisions in this act are necessary for the proper
11	distribution of funds by the county treasurer, and the implementation of the
12	act is necessary to allow proper receipt and distribution of the school funds
13	prior to the beginning of the school year. Therefore, an emergency is
14	declared to exist and this act being immediately necessary for the
15	preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall become effective on
16	<u>Jul y 1, 2001.</u>
