REGULAR SALARIES. There is hereby established for the Department of Human Services - Division of State Services for the Blind for 26 27 the 2001-2003 biennium, the following maximum number of regular employees whose salaries shall be governed by the provisions of the Uniform 28 29 Classification and Compensation Act (Arkansas Code §§21-5-201 et seq.), or its successor, and all laws amendatory thereto. Provided, however, that any 30 31 position to which a specific maximum annual salary is set out herein in 32 dollars, shall be exempt from the provisions of said Uniform Classification 33 and Compensation Act. All persons occupying positions authorized herein are hereby governed by the provisions of the Regular Salaries Procedures and 34 35 Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-101), or its successor.

SECTION 2. EXTRA HELP. There is hereby authorized, for the Department of Human Services - Division of State Services for the Blind for the 2001-2003 biennium, the following maximum number of part-time or temporary employees, to be known as "Extra Help", payable from funds appropriated herein for such purposes: fourteen (14) temporary or part-time employees, when needed, at rates of pay not to exceed those provided in the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act, or its successor, or this act for the appropriate classification.

 1 SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION - OPERATIONS. There is hereby appropriated, to 2 the Department of Human Services - Division of State Services for the Blind, 3 to be payable from the paying account as determined by the Chief Fiscal 4 Officer of the State, for personal services and operating expenses of the Department of Human Services - Division of State Services for the Blind for 5 6 the biennial period ending June 30, 2003, the following:

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SECTION 4. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. FUND BALANCES. (A) For all appropriations as provided in this Act, the agency disbursing officer shall monitor the level of fund balances in relation to expenditures on a monthly basis. If any proposed expenditures would cause a fund balance to decline to less than fifty percent (50%) of the balance available on July 1, 2001, the disbursing officer shall immediately notify the executive head of the agency. Prior to any obligations being made under these circumstances, the agency head shall file written documentation with the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State requesting approval of the expenditures. Such documentation shall provide sufficient financial data to justify the expenditures and shall

- 9 (B) The Chief Fiscal Officer of the State shall review the request and
- 10 approve or disapprove all or any part of the request, after having sought
- 11 prior review by the Legislative Council.

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13 SECTION 5. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized

14 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds

made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the

16 restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and

17 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary

18 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal

19 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by

the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be

21 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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SECTION 6. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly
that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained
in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act
was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations
and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by

28 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral

29 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or

Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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- 32 SECTION 7. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
- 33 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
- 34 appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the
- 35 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2001 is essential to the operation of
- 36 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in

1	the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective
2	date of this Act beyond July 1, 2001 could work irreparable harm upon the
3	proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.
4	Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being
5	necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
6	safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2001.
