Arkansas Code 10-3-101 is amended to read as follows: 26 10-3-101. Presession assignment of regular standing committees. The presession assignments of members of regular standing Senate and 27 House committees and the designation of committee chairman and vice chairman 28 29 shall be made by the Senate Committee on Committees in the Senate pursuant to 30 the Senate Rules and in the House by the House Speaker-elect as soon as is 31 feasible after each biennial general election. 32 33 SECTION 2. Arkansas Code 10-3-701(c), concerning the Joint Committee on Public Retirement and Social Security Programs, is amended to read as follows: 34 35 (c)(1) The Committee on Committees of the Senate shall name, at At the commencement of each regular session of the General Assembly or at any time a 36

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- vacancy exists, ten (10) members of the Senate shall be named pursuant to the
 Senate Rules to serve on the joint committee. Vacancies shall be filled
 pursuant to the Senate Rules.
 - (2) The Senate Committee on Committees shall designate Pursuant to the Senate Rules one (1) Senate member of the committee shall be designated to serve as Senate cochairman of the committee and one (1) Senate member shall be designated to serve as Senate vice chairman of the committee.

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- SECTION 3. Arkansas Code 10-3-802 is amended to read as follows:
- 10 10-3-802. Joint Standing Committee on Energy Membership Cochairmen.
- 11 (a) There is created a joint standing committee of the House of 12 Representatives and the Senate of the Arkansas General Assembly to be known as
- 13 the "Joint Committee on Energy".
- 14 (b)(1) The committee shall be a select committee of the House and 15 Senate, whose members shall be chosen as follows:
 - (A) Seven (7) members of the Senate to be named by the Senate Committee on Committees pursuant to the Senate Rules; and
 - (B) Thirteen (13) members of the House of Representatives to be selected as provided by House Rule.
 - (2)(A) Each Senate member is authorized to appoint a member of the Senate to serve as his or her alternate on the committee; and
- 22 (B) One (1) alternate member for each of the thirteen (13) 23 House members shall, according to House Rule, be selected as prescribed by 24 House Rule.
 - (3) Senate members and alternate Senate members of the Joint Committee on Energy shall be appointed at each regular biennial session of the General Assembly and shall serve until the convening of the next regular session of the General Assembly.
 - (c) Members appointed to the Joint Committee on Energy shall serve on the committee in addition to their service on the regular standing and select committees of the Senate.
- (d)(1)(A) The Senate Committee on Committees shall designate one One
 (1) of the Senate members of the Joint Committee on Energy shall be designated

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     Review Committee, is amended to read as follows:
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           (a) There is hereby created the "Joint Performance Review Committee",
     which shall consist of twenty (20) members of the House of Representatives to
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     be selected as prescribed by House Rule and seven (7) members of the Senate to
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     be appointed by the Senate Committee on Committees pursuant to the Senate
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             There shall be a Senate cochairman and a House cochairman and a Senate
     vice chairman and a House vice chairman of the committee. The House cochairman
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     and House vice chairman shall be selected according to House Rules. The Senate
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     cochairman and Senate vice chairman shall be selected according to Senate
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     Rul es.
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           SECTION 5. Arkansas Code 10-3-1703 is amended to read as follows:
           10-3-1703. Joint Committee on Advanced Communications and Information
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     Technology - Membership - Cochairmen.
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           (a)(1) There is created a joint standing committee of the House of
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     Representatives and the Senate of the General Assembly to be known as the
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     "Joint Committee on Advanced Communications and Information Technology".
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                      This joint committee shall function as established by law.
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           (b)(1) The committee shall be a select committee of the House of
     Representatives and the Senate, whose members shall be chosen as follows:
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                       (A)(i) Seven (7) members of the Senate, to be named by the
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     President Pro Tempore, and with vacancies to be filled by the Committee on
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     Committees without regard to the Senate rule on seniority consist of the
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     members of the Senate Committee on Technology and Legislative Affairs.
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                             (ii) Each Senate member is authorized to appoint a
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     member of the Senate to serve as his or her alternate on the committee Any
     vacancy shall be filled according to the Senate rules on seniority; and
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                       (B)(i) Seven (7) Ten (10) members of the House of
     Representatives to be selected by the Speaker of the House of Representatives.
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1	(ii)(a) One (1) alternate member for each of the
2	House members shall be selected by the Speaker.
3	(b) Vacancies in the House membership on the
4	committee shall be filled by the Speaker in accordance with House rules.
5	(2) In the event a vacancy shall occur on the Joint Committee on
6	Advanced Communications and Information Technology, the vacancy shall be
7	filled in the manner as provided for in this section.
8	(c) Members appointed to the Joint Committee on Advanced Communications
9	and Information Technology shall serve on the committee in addition to their
10	service on the regular standing, joint, and select committees.
11	(d)(1) The President Pro Tempore of the Senate shall designate one (1)
12	of the Senate members of the Joint Committee on Advanced Communications and
13	Information Technology to serve as the Senate cochairman of the committee <u>The</u>
14	chairperson of the Senate Committee on Technology and Legislative Affairs
15	shall serve as the Senate cochairperson of the committee, and the Speaker of
16	the House of Representatives shall designate one (1) of the House members
17	appointed to the Joint Committee on Advanced Communications and Information
18	Technology to serve as the House cochairman of the committee.
19	(2) The cochairmen of the Joint Committee on Advanced
20	Communications and Information Technology shall preside at alternate meetings
21	of the committee, unless the cochairmen shall agree otherwise.
